The tenth Meeting of the Executive Council was held at the India International Centre, New Delhi, at 11.00 a.m. on Saturday, the 20th March 1976. The following members were present constituting the required quorum:

EC10 76:01 CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES

The Minutes of the Ninth Meeting of the Executive Council held in New Delhi on the 20th November 1975, having been circulated, were confirmed.

EC10 76:02 BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

1. The Expansion of the Department of Mathematics

Dr U.N. Singh and Dr B.M. Udgaonkar made the following recommendations regarding the scheme of expansion suggested by Dr Daya-Nand Verma:

- a) There need not be a course entitled M.Sc Honours. The Department should concentrate

contd.

on making the M.Sc course into a good course.

- b) Provision should be made in the University's budget for enabling staff of all Departments including the Mathematics Department to travel in connection with their on-going research during the winter months. The UGC travel schemes may also to be availed of.
- c) Travelling Allowance for research scholars called for interview is permissible.
- d) The University has already made provision for Visiting Professorships and the Mathematics Department can also utilize the scheme.
- e) While not specifying the exact amount it was recommended that the Department should be assisted to get a substantial number of books and journals, including back numbers of journals.
- f) Reprographic equipment which is purchased should belong to a common pool so that it can be used by more than one department.
- g) The Department of Mathematics may be given an electric typewriter.
- h) Regarding staff it was recommended that the appointment of one professor and three readers may be sanctioned.
- i) Regarding the request for a staff member for the Mathematics Department; this is a policy matter and so the Department should be entitled to whatever is being done for other departments.
- j) The Mathematics Department should be provided with clerical assistance in keeping with the norms set up for all departments but an additional steno-typist or stenographer may be sanctioned.
- k) The Department could invite post-doctoral fellows to work with the Department for periods ranging from 2 to 3 years. Pre-doctoral or junior fellows could be given fellowships upto 3 years.

The Executive Council APPROVED of these recommendations.

2. Purchase of Mayurbhanj House

The Vice-Chancellor reported that the month's

notification required expires on April 27th after which the property can be taken over by the University.

3. Engineering Cell

The Vice-Chancellor reported that the Campus Development Committee which met on the 19th March 1976 had requested Mr P.L. Verma to prepare a note on Engineering Cell. Mr P.L. Verma has kindly agreed to submit the note as early as possible.

EC10 76:03 REPORTING ITEMS

1. Principals' Conference

The Vice-Chancellor gave a report of the Principal's Conference held in Shillong from the 10th to the 14th of February, 1976 at which 25 out of the 29 Principals were present. The Executive Council approved of the request of the Principals that there should be an annual meeting lasting three days to which educational experts could also be invited to participate.

2. Report of the Continuing Education Department

The Vice-Chancellor tabled the report of the Continuing Education Department and he observed that the Department of Continuing Education was doing good work in Shillong and in the region as a whole.

3. Dr Zakir Hussain Memorial Lectures

The Vice-Chancellor reported that the Dr Zakir Hussain Memorial Lectures for 1975-76 were delivered at the North-Eastern Hill University by an eminent Indian Sociologist, Prof. M.N. Srinivas, on the 12th and the 13th March, 1976. The Chief Rector, Shri L.P. Singh, Governor of Meghalaya and Nagaland, presided over the first meeting.

4. Commemorative Meeting in honour of the late Dr Verrier Elwin

The Vice-Chancellor reported that a Commemorative Meeting was held in honour of late Dr Verrier Elwin on the 13th March, 1976, in Shillong. Shri N.K. Rustomji, ICS, Chief Secretary, Meghalaya Government and a close friend of Dr Elwin, presided over the meeting.

EC10 76:04 THE FIRST CONVOCATION AND MATTERS PERTAINING TO IT

The Vice-Chancellor reported that the first Convocation of the University would be held at the Garrison Ground from 11.00 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. on the 24th April, 1976. The Vice-Chancellor extended an invitation to all the members of the Executive Council and requested them to make it convenient to attend the Convocation.

RESOLVED that the Vice-Chancellor be authorised to make all necessary arrangements for making the Convocation a success and be empowered to incur any expenditure needed in this connection.

EC10 76:05 LETTERS FROM THE UGC AND THE MINISTRY REGARDING THE REQUEST OF THE MIZORAM GOVERNMENT FOR AND MAINTAINING UNIVERSITY COLLEGE AT AIZAWL.

RESOLVED that the Expert Committee be requested to examine the matter in question and submit the report.

EC10 76:06 MEMORANDUM REGARDING THE SETTING UP OF AN EXPERT COMMITTEE

RESOLVED also that steps be taken to get the Course approved by the UGC so that it may be recognized by State Governments, other Universities etc.

The request of Dr (Mrs) Sujata Miri who had applied both for lecturer's post and the reader's post in Philosophy asking to be promoted as reader was considered.

RESOLVED that Mrs Miri be informed that she should apply for the post of Reader when advertised as all posts are now selection posts after the introduction of the new UGC scales.

RESOLVED that the question of a revised and uniform scale for college teachers within the jurisdiction of NEHU be taken up with the State and Union Territories concerned.

EC10 76:10 AWARD OF FELLOWSHIP TO DR R. LALTHANTLUANGA,
LECTURER, ZOOLOGY DEPARTMENT

RESOLVED that Dr R. Lalthantluanga be granted leave with pay for one year from the date of his proceeding on leave.

RESOLVED also that the Vice-Chancellor be authorized to grant Dr R. Lalthantluanga the necessary leave as per rules provided that before availing of the leave Dr Lalthantluanga will execute a bond as prescribed for the purpose in favour of the University binding himself for the fulfilment of the conditions laid down in Cl.10; Sub clause (XIII) and XIV of the Ordinance for a period of three years. Provided also that Dr Lalthantluanga will submit to the Registrar six monthly reports of progress of his research/studies from his supervisor/head of the Institution as required under Cl.10 Sub Clause (XVI) of the Ordinance failing which payment of his leave salary may be deferred till receipt of such report.

RESOLVED that the rates of fees fixed by the Vice-Chancellor for receiving Degrees in person and in

absentia be approved.

RESOLVED further that a late fee of Rs.5/- (Rupees five only) from the applicants applying for Degree in absentia or in person three years after the first Convocation be levied.

EC10 76:15 NOMINATION OF UNIVERSITY TEACHERS TO THE GOVERNING BODIES OF THE AFFILIATED COLLEGES

RESOLVED that the University Teachers nominated by the Vice-Chancellor to the Governing Bodies of the affiliated colleges be ratified (Appendix I).

EC10 76:16 REMUNERATION FOR INTERNAL PRACTICAL EXAMINERS FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE UNIVERSITY PRACTICAL EXAMINATIONS

RESOLVED that the maximum remuneration payable to Internal Examiners be raised to Rs.150/- (Rupees one hundred and fifty only).

EC10 76:17 CONSULTATION WITH PROF. RAVI J. MATTHAI

A stimulating talk on Planning in an organizational set-up was given by Prof. Ravi Matthai. All the members present appreciated the talks. A paper on the structure of the University will be submitted to the Executive Council.

EC10 76:18 PROF. L.R. SHAH

The Vice-Chancellor reported that Prof. L.R. Shah, who is doing excellent work as Director of Continuing Education has been asked to join the Ministry of Education as a Programme Adviser. Prof. Shah would like to accept the appointment for a short period mainly for domestic reasons. He has requested that he might be deputed to the Ministry.

RESOLVED that the Vice-Chancellor be authorized to discuss the matter with the Ministry of Education in order to find a solution to the problem.

EC10 76:19 SANCTION FOR EXTRA STAFF NEEDED IN SOCIOLOGY IN 1976-77

The Vice-Chancellor reported that Dr G.S. Aurora

has joined. The extra staff needed in Sociology for the year 1976-77 was considered. The Executive Council recommended two Readers and two Lecturers be sanctioned.

EC10 76:20 THE SARAT CHANDRA BIRTH CENTENARY
CELEBRATIONS

The Vice-Chancellor reported that the citizens of Shillong would be celebrating the Birth Centenary of the great novelist Shri Sarat Chandra Chatterji from the 19th to the 22nd April, 1976.

The Vice-Chancellor had, on request from the Organizing Committee, invited Dr S.P. Sen, Vice-Chancellor, Calcutta University and Dr Nabonita Deb Sen of Jadhavpur University to deliver lectures on the occasion.

RESOLVED that the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor be approved.

EXTRA STAFF NEEDED

RESOLVED to sanction two Readers and three Lecturers and to refer the matter to the Sub-Committee.

EC10 76:24 LOCATION OF THE SCHOOL OF EDUCATION

RESOLVED that the matter be referred to the Expert Committee for making necessary recommendations in this regard.

EC10 76:25 KHASI SYMPOSIUM

The recommendations of the Khasi Symposium held under the auspices of the NEHU were tabled for further consideration.

EC10 76:26 INDO-BULGARIAN CULTURAL EXCHANGE

Dr P.S. Ramakrishnan, Professor of Botany, has been nominated for a month's visit under this programme for a period of one month to Bulgaria.

The Executive Council RESOLVED to grant Dr P.S. Ramakrishnan the necessary leave in order to go to Bulgaria. He will be on full pay during the period of his absence.

EC10 76:27 MEGHALAYA COLLEGE TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION

The views of the Meghalaya College Teachers' Association communicated to the Meghalaya Education Commission of which the Vice-Chancellor is Chairman were tabled for the information of the members of the Executive Council.

ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL MATTERS

EC10 76:28 THE VICE-CHANCELLOR'S TA/DA RULES

The Vice-Chancellor said he felt embarrassed that this had been pending since his appointment though Statute 1(4)(iii) of the Schedule of NEHU Act lays it down that "The Vice-Chancellor shall be entitled to travelling allowance at such rates as may be fixed by the Executive Council".

After discussion, the Executive Council RESOLVED that:

- i) The Vice-Chancellor shall be treated as on a par with a Secretary to the Government

of India as far as his TA/DA rules are concerned.

- 2) That since NEHU is an institutional member of the India International Centre, New Delhi, his actual expenses in terms of board and lodging shall be met by the University. This will have retrospective effect from the date of his appointment.
- 3) The Vice-Chancellor should also be entitled to a sumptuary allowance in order to enable him to meet legitimate entertainment allowances in connection with his official work. A proposal in this regard may be placed before the next meeting of the Executive Council.

EC10 76:29 CASE WORKSHOP AT THE ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF COLLEGE AT HYDERABAD FOR ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS
