AMENDMENT PROPOSALS TO THE CONSTITUTION ETC. OF THE SPORTS BOARD NORTH-EASTERN HILL UNIVERSITY.

<u>Clause/ Rule No.</u>	<u>Existing Clause</u>	<u>Amendment Proposals</u>
1:1	There shall be established a Sports Board to be called "The North-Eastern Hill University Sports Board" (hereinafter referred to as the Board) and shall come into force on such date as the University by Notification may appoint.	As existing.
1:2	The Headquarter of the Board shall be in Shillong and its jurisdiction shall extend to all Colleges maintained by or affiliated to the University and to the Campuses in Shillong and Aizawl.	The Headquarters of the Board shall be in Shillong and its jurisdiction shall extend to all Colleges maintained by or affiliated to the University and to the Campuses in Shillong, Tura and Aizawl.
4:5(i)	The Board shall appoint for the above purposes, Standing Committee for any or all of the following:-  Basketball, Boxing, Chess, Cricket (Men), Cricket (Women), Cycling, Football (Men), Football (Women), Swimming, Gymnastic (Men), Gymnastic (Women), Hockey (Men), Hockey (Women), Table Tennis (Men), Table Tennis (Women), Volleyball (Men), Volleyball (Women), Wrestling, Athletics, Weightlifting, Best Physique, Badminton (Men), Badminton (Women).	As existing.
	<u>Note:-</u> The Board may appoint, when necessary, more Standing Committees, including Reception/Organisation Committees, for any specific purpose or period.	

- (a) Each Standing Committee shall be composed of a Convenor and at least five members, who may or may not be members of the Board and shall include the Coach(s) in the game concerned if available. The Convenor may, if it deemed necessary, co-opt additional members including students.
- (b) Each Standing Committee, except the Grounds Standing Committee, shall be unless otherwise specified, for the conduct of Inter University Competitions and Tournaments, and subject to the overall control of the Board, shall have the following responsibilities:
- i) Drawing up programmes and ties of the Tournaments.
  - ii) Making arrangements for the supervision on the Competition or Tournament.
  - iii) Selecting and training of team to represent the University.
  - iv) Adjudication on all cases of disputes on protest that may be referred to them.
  - v) Maintenance of order and discipline in its own sphere of activities. It shall refer all cases requiring disciplinary action to the Sports Board.
  - vi) The Grounds Standing Committee shall arrange for the maintenance of the Ground tents, and other equipment in proper order, and shall be responsible for the allotment of the grounds.

Each Standing Committee shall be composed of a Convenor and at least five members, who may or may not be members of the Board and shall include the Coach(s) in the game concerned if available. The Convenor may, if it deemed necessary, co-opt additional members including students. The Convenor of each Standing Committee shall be the Secretary of the Sports Board.

Each Standing Committee shall be unless otherwise specified, for the conduct of Inter College and Inter University Competitions and Tournaments, and subject to the overall control of the Board, shall have the following responsibilities:

- i) Adjudication on all cases of disputes on protest that may be referred to them.
- ii) Maintenance of order and discipline in its own sphere of activities. It shall refer all cases requiring disciplinary action to the Sports Board.

6:2 The Assistant Director of Sports of each Campus, i.e. in Mizoram and Meghalaya, shall act as convenor of the Zonal Committee in their respective campuses.

The Assistant Director of Sports of each Campus i.e. in Shillong, Tura and Aizawl, shall act as convenor of the Zonal Committee in their respective campuses.

RULES FOR CONDUCT OF TOURNAMENT.

1:3(a) Tournaments in various games shall be played on knock-out and/or league basis as may be decided by the Sports Board or the relevant Standing Committee.

As existing.

NOTE:- Tie draws, seeding etc., shall be made by the relevant standing Committees in accordance with the rules of the game concerned and shall conform generally to the rule 8 and regulations of the Association of Indian Universities.

1:2	To include Tura Campus under the jurisdiction of the Sports Board.
4:5(a)	To specify who will be the Convenor of the Standing Committees.
4:5(b)	(a) To remove the provisions of a Grounds Standing Committee as in the past, members of such Committees hardly visit the grounds; thus, the responsibility always falls on the Sports Department itself and this arrangement has been working satisfactorily.  (b) To delete 4:5(i), (ii), (iii) and (vi) as it has been found that such Committees have not functioned satisfactorily in the past; on many occasions, the members do not attend the meetings of such Committees which are convened frequently and the responsibility has always fallen on the Sports Department itself. The responsibility of these Standing Committees may, therefore, be limited to adjudication and maintenance of discipline.
6:2	To prepare for the creation of the branch of the Sports Department in Tura and the creation of a post of Assistant Director of Sports there.
