

VIII LIBRARY DEPARTMENT

The NEHU Library system consisting of a Central Library, 5 Departmental Libraries, 2 Campus Libraries and 2 Constituent College Libraries made steady progress during the period under review. The system took up several measures to improve the efficiency of the services. The following are the major achievements :

Decentralisation of Acquisition

Observing that the centralisation of acquisition was resulting in unnecessary delay, a policy was evolved by which acquisition of books was decentralised to the level of Campus Libraries and Constituent Colleges. This policy has started to play its role in the strengthening of the collections of Campus Libraries and Constituent Colleges.

Standing Library Committee

The scope of the Standing Committee was extended so as to have sub-committees at Campus and Constituent College level and to include representatives from sub-committees in the Standing Library Committee.

Transfer of books available in multiple copies in the Central Library to other Campuses on permanent basis

During the year the Library with the help of teachers sorted out books found in multiple copies and transferred some copies to Campus Libraries. This has not only helped to solve the immediate problem of space at the Central Library but also contributed a lot to the strengthening of the collections at Campus level.

Acquisition of books

About 5,166 new books were added to the Library. These include text books, books on North-East and new books on different subjects.

Government Publications

As part of keeping the Library Collection upto-date with data and Government Reports, the Library continued receiving Government Publications on gratis. About 500 such publications were received.

Introduction of Identity Card System

As the Library was facing a number of problems due to the practice of transfer of Cards by students and research scholars, Identity Card System was introduced for the circulation system and gate check. This has resulted in prevention and control of such malpractices.

Course Book Section

When it was found that text books are being pilfered, the Library created a Course Book Section where all prescribed text and other important books are kept in close access. Books from this Section marked 'CB' have to be returned within a week. This has greatly improved proper circulation of books amongst all students and helped in preventing pilferage of text books.

Index List of text books

Lists compiled according subjects were brought out with the purpose to provide new students with ready information about text and important reference books available in the Library.

Reprographic Services

A Plain Paper Copier was added this year which has further improved the services.

Bindery Section

During the year the Section was furnished with following equipment :

IX. COLLEGE DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL

The UGC has extended the term of its assistance to the College Development Council upto the end of the Sixth Five Year Plan period.

In February 1983, a workshop on the General Foundation Course was held in Shillong in which two teachers from each affiliated college attended. Books on the Foundation Course and also Model Question papers had been published by the University and despatched to the Colleges.

After a series of discussions with the Principals of the affiliated colleges and the representatives of the State Governments of Meghalaya, Nagaland and the Union Territory of Mizoram, the University has finally decided to change the academic calendar with effect from 1984.

The North-Eastern Hill University has adopted the Ordinance of the Gauhati University in matters relating to the granting of affiliations to colleges. The Ordinance has been amended with a view to suit the particular conditions prevailing in the hill areas under NEHU's jurisdiction. During the year there were no new colleges being affiliated. Kolasib college was upgraded to degree level in the 1982-83 session.

The performances of some the affiliated colleges are included in this report, However reports from some colleges have not been received. Maintenance of students discipline in the colleges have been very good during the year.

SHORT REPORT OF THE COLLEGES

Meghalaya Colleges

1. St Anthony's College

St Anthony's College was established in the year 1934, when the Salesians of Don-Bosco felt that Shillong needs a college to cater to the needs of the local population especially the tribals of the state who had no opportunity to attend higher studies outside the state. The opening of the college was a great contribution to the cause of educational upliftment to the tribal community by the Salesians of Don Bosco. Today it has grown tremendously. It has about 200 students on rolls in all faculties of Arts, Science, and Commerce and became a society by itself but it has not changed its attitude towards the tribals of the State. It gives them top most priority in admission and in teaching. The college has recently opened up a new department of Pisciculture of Biological Sciences. Besides the shifting of the college to a new campus has given a positive educational atmosphere. It is hoped that this will go a long way to make St. Anthony's College live up to its motto "Ever More and Better Ever."

2. St. Edmund's College :

St. Edmund's College of the Christian Brothers a Registered Charitable Society was founded by Sir Archdale Earle, Chief Commissioner of Assam, in 1916. Situated in spacious grounds it gives an ideal environment for student life. The object of this institution is to train youngmen in the habits of discipline, inspire them for religious tolerance and to prepare them for their future career. For some years, the College confined its attention to the Cambridge and Higher Level Examinations. As early as 1924, the College Authorities responding to public demand, introduced Intermediate classes in Arts and Science and affiliation was granted by Calcutta University in the same year. St. Edmund's College was thus the first Institution in the capital of Assam to offer College Education to students residing in Shillong, "the Queen of Hill Stations".

In 1936 B. A. and B.T. classes were opened and in 1959 B. Sc. classes upto Honours standard were started.

Introduction of 10+2+4 system in the College

The College has already switched over 10+2+4 system of education which was decided by the University. Students for +2 P. U. (Agri.) courses had been admitted in 1982-83rd session.

College status change to School

The status of the College of Agriculture has been raised to the School of Agricultural Sciences and Rural Development in order to bring it at par with other Schools of the University.

Establishment of Centre for Rural Development.

The development in science and technology hardly finds an outlet to the rural masses as a result the technology has by and large continued to be traditional especially in the North-Eastern Hill Region.

The planning machinery that works from the above, has not been able to involve the masses, and the social education is yet to make sufficient headway in evoking response. In operating the development schemes and inducing new technologies it is necessary to gain the confidence of the people and make them leaders of their own progress. An understanding of the tribal concept of development and the society that often stand in the way, is essential.

The main object of the centre shall be to train personnel to mobilize the village block for the purpose of Rural Development to serve as an operative agency.

Introduction of non-traditional course

The College has started non-traditional courses in general arts and science streams. In the first phase it has been taken up by the Patkai Christian College, where a full-fledged course in horticulture has been started.

10. Zunheboto College

The Zunheboto College a new College in Nagaland has completed 3 (three) academic sessions in 1982-83.

The College started its first evening session in the Government High School at Zunbhoto in 1980-81. Classes were run between 3.00 p.m. to 8.00 p.m. The College was shifted to the present campus in the 1981-82 session and classes are running in the day shift. Since the College is situated 4 Km. away from the town, the Nagaland State Transport provided transport service to both teachers and students.

Extension of College Campus/Buildings

Besides the 3 (three) existing buildings which were donated by the S.B.A.K. (the Sema Baptist Association), the college has now 2 (two) more staff quarters which were about Rs. 40,000/- from the college Fund. The College Football ground has also been completed at the end of 1982-83 session. The work of the playground has been carried out by the army personnel of the Mountain Division.

Students of the College are taking keen interest in the field of Sports and Games. The college teams participated in the district sports meets as well as in the Inter-Collegiate Sports meets organised by NEHU. FINANCE : The College depends for its income mainly on the voluntary donations and contributions. It has received Grant-in-aid from the Government of Nagaland from the Session 1981-82. It received Rs.65,000/- as Grant-in-aid from the Session 1982-83. The College has not received any financial assistance from the U.G.C. till 1983.

The relationship between students and teachers is very cordial and it is expected that the rise in the standard of education in the College will further improve.

X. DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICAL TRAINING, SPORTS & GAMES

On August 10, 1982, Mr. M.G. War, Director of Sports was reverted back to the Government of Meghalaya and Dr. Imdad Hussain, Dean of Student' Welfare took charge in addition to his other duties. The newly constituted Sports Board met only as an informal meeting which was presided by Prof. Mrinal Miri in the absence of the Chairman, Dr. B.D Sharma, Vice-Chancellor who was indisposed. The Board approved the holding of the inter-College Sports and Games in December, 1982.

Inter-College Sports

The Inter-College Sports could not be held owing to a variety of problems. Several colleges expressed their inability to participate as students had to prepare for the examinations. In Shillong, due to the non-availability of playgrounds and the delay of the district authority in giving clearance for the meet in time has hampered the Sports programmes of the University.

However, the Inter-College Cricket Tournament was conducted at Shillong from Nov. 20 to December, 1982, Six colleges participated, involving nearly 90 students from Meghalaya Nagaland and Mizoram. In the two day final matches Shillong College defeated St. Anthony's College. Shillong College was declared as Champion.

Participation in Inter-University Tournaments

On the basis of the performance in the Inter-College Cricket tournament the University Cricket team was selected and intensive coaching was provided by Mr. P. J. Lamare, Coach of the department for the participation in the Inter-University Cricket (East Zone) tournament. The Inter-

University Cricket was held at Patna. The NEHU team was defeated in the first match. The University Football Tournament and Table Tennis team were also formed on the basis of selection matches conducted by the department in Shillong. In the Inter-University Football Tournament held at Ranchi, NEHU team reached the quarter finals.

Although the results of the Inter-University Tournament has not been very impressive yet considering the circumstances, in which the teams were placed, their performance is not entirely without credit. Since participation at the Inter-University level had been after a gap of several years, and theirs was inadequate practice as no Inter-College tournament could be held in the last two years. The Students could not stay away from their classes and exploitation of the players could not be given thrust and their performance, could not be improved, so as to reach the national and international standards in the field of Sports & Games.

XI. CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT AND ENGINEERING CELL

In the previous report, a brief mention has been made about the master plan of the University Campus at Shillong which includes the Academic Complex, Housing Complex, Sports Complex and Recreation Centre for the students. To develop the permanent Campus of the NEHU at Shillong, the building programme is proposed to be carried out in a phased manner, the first phase for student population of 1,000, the second phase for another 1,000 and the last phase for the ultimate strength of 4,000.

The first phase programme consists of the construction of the Academic Complex for six schools and the Housing Complex for 200 Nos. for quarters for the teachers and staff and hostels for the students. The Architect has therefore prepared the plans and the estimates for Rs 0.5 crores for the part A-I project in this respect and the same is yet to be approved by the University Grants Commission. At present the University Grants Commission has approved in principle at the initial stage the execution of hostel buildings for 200 students and 50 quarters for the teachers at an estimated cost of Rs. 1.57 crore only. The construction works have been taken up by the University and it is expected that these buildings would be completed within the current financial year of 1983-84.

In addition to the building project it has also been proposed to provide necessary facilities and internal road services in the campus area. For this purpose we have obtained UGC's approval for construction of two ring roads around the Housing Complex and the Academic Complex at an estimated cost of Rs. 63 lakhs. Necessary arrangement for allotting the works to the contractors has since been made.

With the passage of years, the University is growing there has, therefore been a great demand for hostel accommodation from the students from different parts of the region and the rural areas as well. As the University is keen to meet the immediate demand of the students, it was felt necessary that the construction of temporary hostel buildings with Shillong-type specification be taken as an alternative proposal with an estimated outlay of Rs. 2 crores in the first phase. Under this proposal the following buildings are proposed to be constructed :

1. Hostel building 800 seats — (a) Single seated room-300
(b) Double seated room-500

-800
2. Research Students/Staff — 200 seats (in two room suites)
3. School of Social Sciences — (i) Lecture room;
(ii) Library for Social Sciences;
(iii) Auditorium;
(iv) Co-operation Section.

The University Grants Commission has agreed to the above proposal for undertaking the construction of 800 students hostel and 150 quarters for the teachers only. In this regard, the plans and estimate amounting to Rs 2.16 crores for hostel building and Rs 3-18 crores for quarters were submitted to UGC. Their approval and sanction are awaited.

Mizoram

The Pachhunga University College was taken over on 19th April, 1979. On taking over of the College by the University, it was felt necessary that the construction of the College and buildings be taken up to improve it to

the required standard. M/S. Dulal Mukherjee, the Architects and Engineers were appointed to carry out the improvement works has prepared and submitted the plans to the extent of Rs 2,20,65,700/- for the purpose. The estimate was technically cleared by the North-Eastern Council and the same is awaiting UGC's sanction.

Agriculture College at Nagaland

Some progress was also recorded with regard to the transfer of Agriculture College at Nagaland. The proposed Agriculture College site at Punglon was visited by a team of experts. It was suggested that the cement concrete boundary pillar be erected along the boundary of the proposed site, thereafter, the site may be handed over formally to the University for its development.

XII. EXAMINATION DEPARTMENT

The enrolment in the University rose from 24330, during 1981-82 to 24533 of 1982-83, recording a 0.83% increase. The enrolment for boys rose from 15986 to 15956, indicating a declining sign by 0.18% and for girls from 8344 to 8577; recording an increase of 2.79%.

The analysis of the statewide enrolment shows that the enrolment at P.U. level rose from 14583 to 15877, recording a rise of 8.87%. The enrolment for boys rose from 9515 to 10217 (+7.37%) and for girls from 5060 to 5722 (+12.9%). There was a considerable variation in the rate of growth of enrolment between different Streams which is given in the following table

It is thus clear that the highest rise has been in P.U. Arts for boys and in P.U. Commerce for girls. For other streams, the rise and fall of the number of students enrolled can be determined at the table shown above.

The growth rate in different states under the University has been significantly different. The highest growth has been in Nagaland.

The Proportion of girls amongst the total students was 4437 in Meghalaya, 1413 in Nagaland and 1510 in Mizoram. Their proportion in Science was 684 in Meghalaya, 106 in Nagaland and 66 in Mizoram.

The overall performance of the students in P.U. Examination was 30.7% in 1983 compared to 35.3% in 1982 in Arts, and 37.6% in 1983 compared to 35.3% in 1982 in Arts, and 37.6% in 1983 compared to 37.4% in 1982 in Commerce. Out of the successful candidates declared in P.U. Arts (1983) 3.25% were in First Division, 32.29% in Second

Division and 64.45% in Third Division, compared to 3.41% (1st.Div.) 25.88% (2nd Div) and 70.69% (3rd Div) respectively in 1982. For P.U. Science (1983), 19.30% were in 1st. Division 55.79% in 2nd. Division and 24.90% in 3rd. Division compared to 22.39% (1st.Div) 48.00% (2nd.Division) and 29.60% (Third Division) in 1982.

For P.U. Commerce, the percentages of pass in 1983 were 2.80% in 1st. Division, 34.83% in 2nd. Division, and 62.35% in 3rd. Division, compared to 5.64% (1st.Div.), 42.37%(2nd.Div.) and 52.54%(3rd.Div.) in 1982.

The result in different stream has varied considerably. The percentage of students who were declared successful in 1983 was 38.2% in Arts, 50.00% in Science and in Commerce 36.3%. The proportion of the successful candidates in First, Second and Third Division in Arts was 4.214, 1020, in Science 51, 64.85 and in Commerce Nil, 19.95. The girls on the whole fared better with 50% approximately in all subjects in Arts (Degree).

The quality of results has varied considerably in different institutions in the constituent unit. The highest percentage was recorded by St. Mary's College at the B.A.Examination 1983, with 67.82% successful out of which 0.86% were in First Class, 45.21 in Second Class and 21.73 in Third Class. At the B.Sc. Examination, the highest percentage was recorded by St. Edmund's College with 65.67% successful out of which 38.80% were in First Class, 13.43% were in Second Class and 13.43 in Third Class. In B.Com. Examination, St. Anthony's College recorded the highest percentage with 33.33% out of which 10.71% were in Second Class and 22.61 in Third Class, and no candidates secured 1st Class.

On the other extreme in some institutions the pass percentage was as low as 17.14%.

The analysis of the result subject-wise shows that the highest proportion of successful candidates was in History and Political Science and the lowest was in Geography. In B.Sc. the highest percentage was in Botany and lowest in Mathematics.

DEPARTMENT OF GEOLOGY

5. The Post Graduate Geology Department of the North Eastern Hill University has been established in the Science College Campus, Kohima, Nagaland State. Besides this an Undergraduate Geology Department has also been started simultaneously at the Pachhunga University College, Aizawl Mizoram. Initially seven students were admitted to the Post Graduate Geology Department in late 1983. Besides imparting Geological training in the Post Graduate studies leading to M. Sc., it is intended that the faculty members and research scholars will conduct investigations specially on fossil-fuels-petroleum and coal since there are good prospects for both these minerals in the North Eastern Region and the hill areas of Nagaland, Mizoram and Ca har. With this objective in view intensive study will be made on Stratigraphy, Structural Geology, Sedimentology, Geomorphology and, Igneous and Metamorphic Petrology.

In early 1984 the UGC visiting team strongly recommended the initiation of another Geology Department at Shillong for teaching and studies of the crystalline and sedimentary formations of Meghalaya and adjacent areas.

The P. G. Geology Department of the University at Kohima is being supported liberally by the University Grants Commission. At the moment there are three teachers in the Department a Professor and two Lecturers. The other faculty positions available in the Department who are preparing to appear soon in the second semester examination of the M. Sc. All these six students belong to the North East Region and out of these, four students belong to SC/ST Tribe.

The Department is just in its infancy and equipment and apparatus are being obtained for establishing specialist laboratories. Some valuable equipment has already been received. The greatest constraint in this connection is the paucity of laboratory space. However two young teachers of the Department are actively engaged on the geological studies.

of ophiolites and metamorphites of eastern Nagaland and Sedimentological and Geomorphological studies including neotectonics of Nagaland. A lecturer of the Undergraduate Department of Geology, Science College, Kohima, has also applied for Sedimentological and Stratigraphical studies between Kohima and Chumukedima with the ideas of obtaining the doctorate degree. The present professor of the Department is continuing his Micropalaeontological and Stratigraphical studies and has recently contributed two joint research papers on the geological material from NE region. Joint studies between the three faculty members of the Department are going on structure and neotectonics between Kohima and Dimapur and abstracts of papers are being sent for participation in various seminars.

These studies are directly related with the boosting of mineral potential of NE region, especially the fossil-fuels as to industrialization and prosperity of the area.

6. The department has already established links with well established Department of Geology at Gauhati in NE region. It has been receiving support from the Delhi University, Punjab University, Lucknow University. All India Institutions like Geological Survey of India, ONGC, DGM, Nagaland and Coal India Ltd. are extending their cooperation in various ways.

7. The Department being new, and the laboratories being not established has not yet made any attempt to organize all India seminar conference, but its faculty members are participating in various seminars and conferences organized by other institutions.
