A Committee was constituted by the Vice-Chancellor with (i) Prof S K Mishra as Chairperson (2) Prof A K Baruah (3) Dr E D Thomas (4) Prof N Hassan (5) Prof R K Rai and (6) Prof B Lyndem Laso as members to recommend the kind of courses that can be offered under the auspices of the Centre for Distance Education and to recommend amendments to the Ordinance if necessary.

The Committee report is placed at (Annexure-'A') for consideration of the Council and for approval of the recommendations of amendment to the Ordinance on Distance Education.

The above matter was placed before the Academic Council in its 67th meeting wherein the Council has resolved to approve the same in principle and that comments on the course content are to be sent to the Chairman of the concerned Committee for necessary action and the Vice-Chancellor is authorised to approve the Course after action on the Comments have been taken. The Council also desired that the production of reading and other materials should be started immediately.

The Committee discussed the existing Ordinance on the Distance Education and the following were the resolutions of the Committee.

1. The following two courses be started immediately.
 - (a) Post Graduate Diploma in Economics
 - (b) Post Graduate Diploma in Commerce

Both of these courses shall be on one year's duration. The Course content for the above two programmes shall be adopted from the existing PG Degree Courses on NEHU.

The Committee recommends that any modification required in the existing course content may be effected by the Centre with the prior approval of the Chairman, Academic Council and ratified in the next Academic Council Meeting.

2(i) The objective of the correspondence Courses shall be to offer courses AT Post Graduate level to students who have for some reason or other, been deprived of higher education.

THE OBJECTIVE OF THE CORRESPONDENCE COURSES SHALL BE TO OFFER COURSES TO STUDENTS WHO HAVE FOR SOME REASON OR OTHER BEEN DEPRIVED OF HIGHER EDUCATION

Eligibility:

3. Any Graduate

ANY CLASS XII PASSED GRADUATE OF EQUIVALENT TO SUIT THE PROGRAMME CONCERNED

Course Structure:

8(i) The Syllabus of the subject offered would be the same as regular course offered in the University

THE SYLLABUS OF THE SUBJECT OFFERED WOULD ORDINARILY BE THE SAME AS A REGULAR COURSE OFFERED IN A UNIVERSITY

8(ii) A candidate registering for a Post Graduate course under the programme may have a maximum of 5 years to complete and be eligible for the degree and those failing to complete and pass the course within the stipulated time of 5 years, will have to seek fresh admission.

A CANDIDATE REGISTERING FOR A GRADUATE/ POST GRADUATE COURSE UNDER THE PROGRAMME MAY HAVE A MAXIMUM OF FIVE YEARS TO COMPLETE AND BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE DEGREE AND THOSE FAILING TO COMPLETE AND PASS THE COURSE WITHIN THE SYIPULATED TIME OF FIVE YEARS, WILL HAVE TO SEEK FRESH ADMISSION.
