

MINUTES OF THE EIGHTY SEVENTH MEETING OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL

The 87th meeting of the Academic Council was held on the 28th of March, 2012 at 10.00 A.M. in the Multi-use Convention Hall, Permanent Campus, NEHU, Mawkyntroh, Shillong.

The Chairman welcomed all the members to the 87th meeting of the Council.

ITEM NO.1 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES

- (i) **Confirmation of the minutes of the 86th Academic Council, held on 18th November, 2011.**

NO:AC:87:2012:1:(i): The Council considered the Minutes of the 86th meeting of the Academic Council held on 18th November, 2011 and the comments received from the Controller of Examinations on **amendment of Clause-7 of Ordinance-OC-7 on the Masters' Degree Programme in Arts, Science and Commerce**, the Council **RESOLVED** to amend the Minutes as follows:

“A student who does not earn credit(s) in a given semester, for any reason whatsoever, may do so in one of the remaining semester during which she/he is eligible to participate in the curricular programme under the provision of clause 4 above. Provided that if a student is not able to earn atleast 18 credits by the end of the second semester she/he shall not be eligible to move on to the third semester”.

The Council **RESOLVED** to approve the amendment and confirmed the Minutes.

ITEM NO.2**REPORTING ITEM**

- (i) **Proposed amendment of Statute 14(i)(xii) on representatives of teachers from affiliated Colleges to the Academic Council.**

NO:AC:87:2012:2:(i): The Council considered the letter dated 12th March, 2012 received from Prof. Man Mohan Singh, Chairman of the Committee constituted by the 86th meeting of the Academic Council to look into the proposed amendment of Statute 14(i) (xii) on representatives of teachers from affiliated colleges and noted the same. The Council deliberated on the matter of nomination and election of representatives of teachers from affiliated colleges. The Council **RESOLVED** not to amend the Statute 14(i)(xii). The Council further **RESOLVED** to constitute a Committee consisting of Prof. O.P. Singh as Chairman, Prof. A.K. Baruah, Prof. R.N. Sharan, Prof. P. Shukla and Dr.(Ms). Ummapapuswamy. The Committee shall work out the mechanism and co-ordinate the election of representatives of affiliated colleges to the Academic Council.

The Committee constituted earlier by the 86th Academic Council under the Chairmanship of Prof. Man Mohan Singh shall cease to function with immediate effect.

With regard to Sl.No.7 on Ordinance OB-15 on the Rajiv Gandhi Chair for Studies in Protective Discrimination, the Council **RESOLVED** that the Registrar shall send a letter to Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, agreeing with the comments of the UGC pertaining to liability as contained in Sl.No.7. The Council further **RESOLVED** that the University shall write to the Rajiv Gandhi Foundation for enhancement of the endowment fund.

For awarding Grades in any percentage range the following formula shall be applied:
(Base Grade point of percentage range) + [(the difference between the base percentage and percentage obtained) x (grade range) divided by percentage range]. For example, a candidate securing 63% marks shall be awarded grade as $(3.50) + [(63-55) (1) / 10] = 3.5 + 0.8 = 4.30$ and a candidate securing 93%-marks shall be awarded grade as $(5.50) + [93-75) (0.5) / 25] = 5.86$

The Council considered the cut-off date for implementation of the 7 Point Scale under Clause-17 of the NEHU Ordinance OC-7 and **RESOLVED** to implement the same from the 2012-2013 academic session.(OC-7 placed at ANNEXURE-A)



NO:AC:87:2012:6:7: (iv): The Chairman informed the House that the process of preparation of XII Plan proposal has been on lines of the UGC letter.


