

6: 7: Others.

(ii) Constitution of a Women's Cell in the University.

The University is frequently receiving complaints of harassment, discrimination and violence against women employees/students of the University. To avoid such unwanted incidents, the University may have a formal structure for receiving and considering specific complaints of this nature and require to constitute a Women's Cell in the University. The Cell may consist of senior lady employees from different areas of University life (and representatives of Women Students) and the powers and functions of the Cell will be laid down by the Executive Council.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

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6:7- Others.

- (i) Dean's Committee Recommendation for Income Generation and cost saving.

EC:107:2000:6:7:(ii): The Council considered the constitution of a Women's Cell in the University and RESOLVED to authorise the Vice- Chancellor to constitute the Committee which will also spell out the functions of the Cell.

- (v) Status of the teachers / staff temporarily posted to Mizoram Campus / PUC on their repatriation consequent upon creation of Nagaland University.

EC:107:2000:6:7: (v): The Council considered the status of the teachers/staff temporarily posted at the Mizoram Campus and PUC and RESOLVED to authorise the Chairman to take a decision about suitable placement at Shillong or Tura after a dialogue with the concerned departments. It was further RESOLVED that, if Mizoram University needs the services of some of these employees at the initial stage, they may remain at Aizawl on deputation from NEHU and be repatriated to NEHU in a phased manner.
