(iii) The teacher shall execute a bond, with proper securities as in the case of study leave, that after the expiry of sabbatical leave he will return to the service of the University and serve thereafter at least for three years, failing which he will return to the University the leave salary and allowances and other expenses if any spent on him, or on his behalf plus such amount as may be decided by the Executive Council from time to time if the teacher is allowed to go abroad for sabbatical leave together with interest at the rate of 6% per annum to be calculated from the date of such payment. Provided that the Executive Council may in any exceptional case, waive or reduce for reasons to be recorded, the

Sabbatical Leave

11. (i) Permanent wholetime teachers of the University who have completed three years of service may be granted sabbatical leave to undertake study or research or other academic pursuits solely for the object of increasing their proficiency and usefulness to the University. This leave shall not be granted to a teacher who has less than three years of service in the University to retire.
- (ii) The duration of leave shall not exceed six months or one year according as the teacher has actually worked in the University for not less than three or six years respectively since his return from the earlier spell of sabbatical leave. Provided further that sabbatical leave shall not be granted until the expiry of three years from the date of the teacher's return from previous study leave or any other kind

NORTH-EASTERN HILL UNIVERSITY ORDINANCES

of training programme, or extra-ordinary leave under clause 8(ii) and (iii).

(iii) The teacher shall execute a bond, with proper sureties as in the case of study leave, that after the expiry of sabbatical leave he will return to the service of the University and serve thereafter at least for three years, failing which he will refund to the University the leave salary and allowances and other expenses if any, spent on him, or on his behalf plus such amount as may be decided by the Executive Council from time to time if the teacher is allowed to go abroad for sabbatical leave together with interest at the rate of 6% per annum to be calculated from the date of such payment. Provided that the Executive Council may, in any exceptional case, waive or reduce, for reasons to be recorded, the amount refundable by a teacher under this Ordinance.

(iv) A teacher shall, during the period of sabbatical leave be paid full pay and allowances (subject to the prescribed conditions being fulfilled) at the rates applicable to him immediately prior to his proceeding on sabbatical leave. The University shall not, however, fill up the post or make other alternative arrangements involving additional expenditure.

(v) A teacher on sabbatical leave shall not take up, during the period of that leave, any regular appointment under another organisation in India or abroad. He may, however, be allowed to accept a fellowship or a research scholarship or ad-hoc teaching and research assignment with honorarium or any other form

of assistance, other than a regular employment in an institution of advanced studies, provided that in such cases the Executive Council may, if it so desires, sanction sabbatical leave on reduced pay and allowances.

- (vi) During the period of sabbatical leave, the teacher shall be allowed to draw the increment on the due date. The period of leave shall also count as service for purposes of pension/contributory provident fund provided the teacher rejoins the University on the expiry of his leave.

- Note :
1. The programme to be followed during sabbatical leave shall be submitted to the University for approval along with the application for grant of leave.
 2. On return from leave, the teacher shall report to the University the nature of studies, research or other work undertaken during the period of leave. He shall also present a resume of his work in a School-level seminar specially organised for the purpose by the Head of the Department.
