The lapse on the part of the Principal PUC has been viewed very seriously and a letter to this effect, sent by the University to him that he should not repeat the same practice in future, has been duly endorsed by the Executive Council.

6 : 6 - Service Conditions/Financial and Other Benefits.

(i) Payment of 10% presumptive pay in respect of Prof. R.Gopalakrishnan .

EC : 94 : 97 ; 6 : 6 : (I): The Council considered payment of 10% of the presumptive pay as laid down under FR-49 (iii) to Prof.R.Gopalakrishnan for holding additional charge of the post of Controller of Examinations and RESOLVED to approve the same with effect from the date of taking charge.

(ii) Payment of monthly remuneration to Dr.E.D.Thomas for holding additional charge as Teacher in charge, Sports Department.

EC ; 94 : 97 ; 6 : 6 : (ii); The Council considered the grant of a monthly remuneration to Dr.E.D.Thomas for holding additional charge of the post of In-charge of the Sports Department and RESOLVED to approve the same.

(iii) Upgradation and Rationalisation of Pay Scales in respect of Store Keepers and Asstt.Press Manager.

EC : 94 : 97 : 6 : 6 : (iii); The Council considered the Report of the Committee and RESOLVED that the matter be referred to the full Committee with the pro-Vice-Chancellor , Mizoram Campus be also included in the Committee.

(iv) Special Allowance to NEHU Employees

EC : 94 : 97 : 6 : 6 : (iv) The Council unanimously adopted the following resolutions :

Whereas , in order to attract and retain talents for the North - Eastern Hill University (NEHU) , the Special Allowance was granted by NEHU to teachers coming from outside the North -Eastern Region effective

from July 1, 1984 vide its Executive Council's (EC) Resolution in its 41st meeting on August 13, 1984 and the University Grants Commission (UGC) sanction No.F.7-11/82(E-II) dated September 3, 1984;

Whereas, in 1986, on demand from Staff Associations of NEHU, the nomenclature of Special Allowance, in order to cover all employees of NEHU, was inadvertently changed into that of Special Duty Allowance(SDA) vide NEHU Executive Council's Resolution in its 53rd meeting on September 4, 1986;

Whereas, the UGC had sanctioned the payment to NEHU towards Maintenance (Block) Grant on account of SDA vide UGC's letter No.21-7/86(NP-I) dated January 28, 1987;

Whereas SDA had been paid to all employees of NEHU for the last thirteen years as all employees have to face special problems in the difficult situation prevailing in the hill areas within the jurisdiction of NEHU which is of a federal character with two outlying Campuses at Aizawl (Mizoram) and Tura (Meghalaya) located at a distance of about 500 and 300 kilometers respectively from the Headquarters, and charged with the special responsibility under Section 4 of the NEHU, Act, 1973;

Whereas, the UGC vide Letter No.F.10-1/94(CU) of 20th July, 1996 and 4th September, 1996 had forwarded the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, followed by subsequent communications from the UGC and the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MOHRD) in their Letters No.F.10-1/94(CU) of 16th June, 1997 and F.8-16/97-Desk(U) of 25th June, 1997, respectively, wherein the two Authorities have directed NEHU to discontinue the payment of SDA and to recover any additional payment of SDA made since 21st September, 1994 as per the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court;

Whereas, NEHU has complied with the judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court As per the directives from the UGC and the MOHRD vide Notification No.F.27-9/Admn/96-5861 of 3rd July, 1997 on the basis of an earlier EC's Resolution adopted in its 92nd meeting held on 21st March, 1997 and which Notification was duly ratified by the Executive Council in its 93rd meeting held on 15th July, 1997;

Whereas, the same difficult situation in the hill areas within the jurisdiction of NEHU persists and continues unabated, thereby requiring special consideration for certain financial incentives to be extended to all employees of NEHU;

Whereas, the Academic Council of NEHU in its 55th meeting held on 2nd and 3rd May, 1997 had also recommended for the continuance of such special incentives ;and

Whereas, the Staff Associations of NEHU are continuously demanding during July to September 1997 for the payment of the same special financial incentives ;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers under Clauses (j) and (n) of sub-section(1) of Section 26 of the NEHU Act, 1973 the Executive Council of NEHU in its meeting held today the 23rd September, 1997, in order to mitigate the special problems faced by NEHU employees unanimously

RESOLVED to pay Hill Areas Special Allowance to all its employees at the rate of twelve percent of the basic pay subject to a ceiling of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand) only per month with effect from 1st January, 1995. The Executive Council further RESOLVED to give effect to the above Resolution by appropriate Ordinance as framed hereunder:

ORDINANCE OE-10

ON THE HILL AREAS SPECIAL ALLOWANCE TO TEACHING AND NON-TEACHING STAFF

(Under Clauses (j) and (n) of sub-section (1) of Section 26 of NEHU Act, 1973).

1. The members of the teaching and non-teaching staff shall be paid a Hill Areas Special Allowance at the rate of twelve percent of the basic pay subject to a ceiling of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand) only per month.
2. The above Hill Areas Special Allowance is deemed to be effective from 1st January 1995 in addition to the pay in the respective scales and such other allowances as may be sanctioned by the University Grants Commission from time to time.

(i) Constitution of Management Committee for Computer Centre, NEHU, Shillong.

EC ; 94 : 97 : 6 : 7 : (I) : The Council considered the constitution of the Management Committee for the Computer Centre and RESOLVED that the following members may constitute the Committee :
