N.B: One Wooden Meatsafe for all teachers and one Kitchen table for Readers and Professors is being provided where built in facilities is not available.

A similar facilities for quarter is also provided to the non-teaching staff of the University. But so far the furnitures is concerned, no mention has been made and hence, the non-teaching staff who were already provided with Quarters have not been issued any furniture to them.

In order to maintain uniformity amongst the University's Community, it is imperative that the non-teaching staff may also be provided with furnitures as per the scales which is proposed below:-

- A. The Statutory Officers including Group A Officers may be granted furnitures as per the scales applicable to the teachers.

- (i) Transfer of land for setting up an Institute of Hotel Management, Catering Technology and Applied Nutrition.

Chairman, Building Committee and Registrar will also work out the contribution to be made by such organisations towards maintenance of the basic infrastructure such as access roads, water supply, electrical supply, sewage and drainage, security etc., and also to draft an MOU for all such cases.
