

## 6:6: Service Condition/Financial &amp; other Benefits-

(iv) Retirement on invalidation

In terms of Rule 38 of CCS(Pension Rules), an employee can retire from the service on invalidation provided the competent Medical Authority certifies that the employee is mentally or bodily incapacitated for continuing further active service. On this account invalid pension is admissible.

The University had referred the following officials to Medical Board of the University for Medical examination and for confirmation whether they are bodily or mentally fit to continue in the University service.

1.	<u>Mr M Syngkon</u>	A case of Alcohol dependency leading to chronic absenteeism and unproductivity. At present there is no insanity. Recommended to be considered for invalid pension.

3.	<u>Mr T Kharir</u>	Straight leg raising test negative on both side. At present he is not suffering from Sciatica.
