

(iii) TA/DA Advance in respect of Dr. R S. Tripathi.

Dr. R. S. Tripathi has drawn TA/DA advance of Rs.52,140/- on 11.8.95. out of "Part - III Unassigned Grant" for attending the 7th European Ecological Congress held at Hungary in August '95. After repeated request from Finance department, Dr. R.S. Tripathi submitted the TA/DA Final Bill on 20.5.98. after lapse of more than 2 (two) years. Finance department could not entertained the claim of the official as he failed to submit the bill within time limit of one year. The reasons given by Dr. R.S. Tripathi for delay in submission of the were that the Air tickets for the journey were misplaced and got mixed up with other papers which he could ultimately traced out and accordingly enable him to submit the same to Finance department on 20.5.98.

In view of the above circumstances the matter is placed before the E.C. for necessary action.
