- (1) Implementation of Five-Day Week in the University.

The proposal for implementation of Five-Day Week in the University was placed in the 65th meeting of the Academic Council wherein, the Council vide its Resolution No: AC:65:2001:5:8(iv) considered the said proposal and Resolved that the matter be examined by a committee to be appointed by the Chairman.

Accordingly, the said committee in its meeting held on 20.11.01 discussed the matter and submitted its report as per Annexure-'A' which was placed before the Academic Council in its 66th meeting wherein the Council resolved to approve the same and that modalities to keep the Library open on Saturdays as well as changes in the Mess timings of the Hostels to be worked out. However the Examination programme of the University shall not be affected by the five day week shall continue to follow the six day week programme

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

- iii. Semester classes may commence from 1st of August  
and 19th February.

C. Administrative Backup :

1. In view of the recommendation given above, Administration may work out the arrangements for transportation accordingly.
- ii. Administration may make arrangements for kitchen staffs to be on duty on all days as at present.
- iii. Other essential staffs like cleaners, plumbers, Safaiwalas, electricians, etc. will work on 6 or 7 days a week as at present.
- iv. Hostel meal timings may be worked out and kitchen staffs would need to remain on duty accordingly.
