- (i) Framing of an Ordinance on Certificate and Diploma Courses.

The Committee constituted by the Academic Council vide Resolution NO:AC:57:98:5:6(v) on the framing of an Ordinance on Certificate and Diploma Courses met on 22.10.98 and submitted its Report.

The matter was placed before the 59th meeting of the Academic Council and the Council considered the Ordinance on Certificate and Diploma Courses and RESOLVED to approve the same as per Annexure 'A'.

ORDINANCE OA-  
ON CERTIFICATE AND DIPLOMA COURSES

1. The University shall conduct Certificate Courses of one Semester duration (six months) and Diploma Courses of two Semester duration (one year).
2. The Syllabus for the Courses shall be as prescribed by the Board of Post Graduate Studies/ or Steering Committee and approved by the School Board and Academic Council.
3. The eligibility for admission to the Courses shall be as under :

A CERTIFICATE COURSES

10+2 examination Higher Secondary/PU or equivalent.

B. DIPLOMA COURSES

B.A./B.Sc/B.Com or equivalent examination of a University established by law.

4. There shall be an examination conducted by the University at the end of the Course on the date and place to be notified by the University.
5. The medium of instruction and examination shall be English.
6. The Course structure and distribution of marks shall be as under:

A CERTIFICATE COURSES

/inclusive

There shall be 4 Papers of 100 marks which may be /of Practicals which however should not exceed 25% of the total marks.

B DIPLOMA COURSES

There shall be 8 Papers of 100 marks which may be inclusive of Practicals which however should not exceed 25% of the total marks.

7. The minimum pass marks in each of the Papers shall be 40%.  
The successful candidates shall be classified as Under:
  - (i) Second Division- those who obtain 45% or more, but less than 60% of the aggregate marks;
  - (ii) First Division - those who obtain 60% or more, but less than 75% of the aggregate.
  - (iii) A candidate who passes with 75% or more marks in the aggregate shall be declared to have passed the Course with "Distinction".

- (xi) Deputation to Nagaland University in respect of  
Dr. S. Changkija, Scientific Officer, RSIC.
