(vi) Ordinance on condition of Service etc.

The Joint Secretary, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Education, Government of India, New Delhi vide his DO No. F.22-5/97-Desk(U) of April, 7, 1997 (Annexure-'A') apprised the Vice-Chancellor that a Central University has made a grave omission in the manner of resorting to simple resolutions of the Executive Council for considering condition of service instead of framing Ordinances detailing condition of service. He has stressed the importance of having Ordinances framed in such matters and has suggested that the Executive Council may give a blanket approval to the Registrar to incorporate relevant resolutions of the Executive Council in the Existing Ordinances on condition of service.

The above matter was placed before the Academic Council in its meeting held on 2nd and 3rd May, 1997 with the suggestion that such blanket approval may also be given by the Executive Council/Academic Council to incorporate decision for all other Ordinances dealing with all other matters such as examinations, academics etc.

The Academic Council considered the matter and RESOLVED that a Committee consisting of the following may look into the inclusion of all the Executive Council/Academic Council decisions in the Ordinances, Regulations etc.

Therefore, it may be more appropriate if the Statute on pay scale and service condition of Vice-Chancellor is amended as follows:-

Vice-Chancellor shall be paid a salary and other allowances as approved by Government of India/UGC from time to time. Terms and conditions of the service of VC shall be in accordance with the Model Ordinance prepared by UGC and amended thereto from time to time in this behalf.

Moreover, if the University wish to put any specific condition or provide some facility for Vice-Chancellor in addition to what approved by Government/UGC, it may do for a suitable clause in the Statute for the purpose.
