MINUTES OF THE TWENTYFIRST MEETINGS OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL

The 21st Meeting of the Academic Council was held on Thursday, the 21st June, Friday, the 22nd June and Saturday, the 23rd June, 1984, at 3.30 p.m., 3.30 p.m. and 2.00 p.m. respectively, in the Seminar Hall, Mayurbhanj Complex, NEHU, Shillong.

PRESENT

The list of members participating in the meeting is appended as Appendices 1, 2 and 3.

WELCOME

The Council welcomed the new members - Prof. B.S. Tewari, Prof. R.G. Michael and Prof. B.N. Saraswati to the Academic Council.

REGRETS

Apologies for inability to attend the meeting were received from Shri S.K.A. John and Prof. A.C. Bhagavati.

The Chairman informed the Council that it was a very important meeting as the Council will be finalising the blue-print of the University's programmes commencing with the session 1985. The Chairman also informed of the successful appearance of the first batch of 3-year Degree Course and timely declaration of results enabling the colleges to start their teaching from May, 1984. The results this year, the Chairman observed, have shown considerable improvement over the preceding year and this marked a good augury for academic progress in the University. This also was an evidence of stability that the University. This also was an evidence of stability that the University has had during last session and is an indicator that the students have taken the change to the new system, philosophically.

The provisions in relation to the alternatives to be adopted by the Selection Committee will continue to be governed by the existing ordinance of the University.

RESOLVED further that minimum qualification for appointment to the posts of Lecturers as suggested by the UGC vide Schedule II, Schedule III, Schedule VII, Schedule VIII, Schedule IX and Schedule X be approved and incorporated as parts of the Ordinance. For qualification under Schedule V, the Council RESOLVED that the words 'Music & Fine Arts' be substituted by the words "Creative Arts" which will inter-alia include Fine Arts, Music and Performing Arts, Folk Arts and Ethnomusic.

During the general discussion on the qualifications for appointment to the post of Lecturer under Schedule 'V', the Council RESOLVED that Music be introduced as a subject at P.U. and B.A. levels with effect from 1985 and authorised the Vice-Chancellor to appoint a Committee to work out the details.

The Council authorised the Vice-Chancellor to lay down the qualifications for the post of Lecturer in Khasi, Garo, Mizo etc., on the basis of UGC Guidelines and these be also incorporated as part of our Ordinances.

(ii) M.Sc. Syllabus in Geology -

(ii) Change in the new Law Course -

AC:21:04:04:4(ii): The Council RESOLVED that introduction of general Law Course as one of the potential subjects at the Under-Graduate level be approved with effect from the session 1905.

The Council also RESOLVED that eligibility for admission to Law Course from the session 1907 when the students with general law course at the degree level will move up for the new course be restricted to those persons who may have offers any three of the five relevant subjects, viz., Law, Sociology, Economics, History and Political Science.

(iii) Creation of a School of Library Management & Studies in the University.

AC:21:04:04:4(iii): The Council RESOLVED that a separate department of Library Science will not be desirable and should not be established. The structure of the library should be modelled on the pattern of teaching medical institutions. The same staff should work on the practical and instructional part. While all these on practical side need not be engaged in teaching, all those who are entrusted with teaching must have same professional responsibility in the library. The work-load of such professionals should be suitably defined through regulations.

The Council also RESOLVED that the faculty will consist of Asstt. Librarian, Dy. Librarian and Librarians who have been accepted by the UGC as non-~~vacation~~ teachers and given parity in pay scales.

The Council further RESOLVED to authorise the Vice-Chancellor to constitute a Committee to go into the details about the assignment of Department of Library Management and Studies to a school of the University. The Council RESOLVED to allow introduction of Radio and T.V. Technology as a non-traditional course on the basis of the draft syllabus presented by the Head, Deptt. of Physics.



