

(vi) Regulation for Permanent Affiliation of affiliated Colleges.

The Academic Council vide Resolution No.AC:57:98:5:7(iii) has appointed a Committee to frame the Regulation for permanent Affiliation of affiliated Colleges.

The Report of the said Committee was placed before the 63rd meeting of the Academic Council wherein the Council RESOLVED to approve the same as per Annexure 'A'.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE APPOINTED BY THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL  
VIDE RESOLUTION NO:AC:57:98:5:7: (iii) TO FRAME THE REGULATION FOR  
PERMANENT AFFILIATION OF AFFILIATED COLLEGES

Regulation On Permanent Affiliation

1. Any College desirous of permanent affiliation shall apply for the same in the proforma prescribed for the purpose, subject to the following conditions:
2. A college may be eligible for permanent affiliation after ten years of its unconditional affiliation to the University as a degree college.
3. A College shall be inspected by an Inspection team to be appointed as per the Ordinance which shall submit its report to the Affiliation Committee for consideration by the academic Council and approval by the Executive Council.
4. Notwithstanding anything other terms and conditions for affiliation shall be as laid down in the Act, Statutes and Ordinances of the University.

- (ii) Drafting of a Regulation for procedure of examinations, fee structure, attendance and equivalent on Certificate and PG Diploma Courses.

**EC:107:2000:5:1:(ii):** The Council considered the procedure of examinations, fee structure attendance and re-evaluation with regard to Certificate and PG Diploma Courses and RESOLVED that the same will apply as for the Post Graduate Courses.

- (iii) Amendment to admission criteria for M.Sc. Bio-Chemistry.

**EC:107:2000:5:1:(iii):** The Council considered the amendment to the admission criteria for M.Sc. in Bio-Chemistry and RESOLVED that Honours in Bio-Chemistry and Bio-Technology may be given preference over others but should not be the requisite criteria. The Council, further noted with regret that the eligibility criteria as proposed by the Department was notified without the approval of the Executive Council.

- (iv) Revised Ordinance OB-6 and Regulation RB-1-6 relating to affiliation of Colleges.

**EC:107:2000:5:1:(iv):** The Council considered the revised Ordinance OB-6 and Regulation RB-16 relating to affiliation of Colleges and RESOLVED to approve the same as per Annexure 'A'. The Council, further RESOLVED that the University may take up with the respective State Governments the creation of the minimum number of posts of Lecturers for the Colleges to conform with the norms laid down by the University

- (v) Amendments of Ordinance OB-15 on Rajiv Gandhi Chair.
