(i) PROPOSAL FOR AMENDMENT OF THE TERM OF  
OFFICE OF HEADSHIP.

The Executive Council in its resolution No. EC:97:98:5:1:(V), considered the term of office of the Head of a Department upto the age of 60 years. The E.C. resolution No. EC:103:99:5:1:(iii) besides considering the amendment/modifications to the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations of the University had RESOLVED that the date of retirement in respect of teachers shall be 62 years i.e. the existing age of superannuation.

It is therefore suggested that the term of office of the Headship be enhanced to the existing age of superannuation as per amendment further proposed under Clause(3) of Statute-7 as per ANNEXURE . 'A'

The matter is placed before the Council for decision.

- (i) Proposal for amendment of the term of office of Headship.

EC:109:2001:5:1:(i): The Council considered the amendment of Statute 7 and RESOLVED that in continuation of the amendment proposed by the Council vide Resolution No.EC:97:98:5:1:(v) the words " a teacher shall cease to be Head on attaining the age of 60 years" may be replaced by the words " a teacher shall cease to be Head on attaining the age of superannuation".

*5:8- Others.*

- (i) Implementation of Five Day Week in the University.

EC:109:2001:5:8:(i): The Council considered the introduction of the Five Day Week in the University and RESOLVED that the matter may be first placed before the Academic Council.

The Council further RESOLVED that individual Departments should ensure that the prescribed workload of teachers should be strictly implemented. The Council further desired that a Notification be issued enforcing the powers of the Deans of Schools.
