

(ii) Admission criteria for Honours in Three Year Degree Course-I.

6 As per the relevant Ordinance OC-8 the admission to the Degree (Honours) Course "a candidate shall have passed the same with 45% marks in the subject concerned or 45% marks in overall aggregate for the subject not offered taken at the Plus Two Level. Provided further the candidates of streams other than Arts shall also be eligible for admission to the Arts, Stream fulfilling the criteria set".

Now it has been observed that the performance of many Honours candidates are not satisfactory from among the students who had not offered the subject at the Plus Two level.

Therefore it is felt that it will be necessary to amend the Existing Ordinance OC-8 for admission to the Degree (Honours) Course as "a candidate shall have passed the same with 45% marks in the subject concerned with 45% in the aggregate and 50% in aggregate for the subjects not offered taken at the Plus Two Level for all the streams for admission to the Degree(Honours)Course.

The matter was placed before 61st meeting of the Academic Council and the Council RESOLVED that candidates with 45% marks in the subject concerned and 45% marks in the aggregate ~~or 50% marks~~ in the aggregate for subjects not offered at the Plus -2 Level, be admitted to the Honours Courses.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

EC:103:99:5:1: (iii): The Council considered the amendment / modifications to the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations of the University and RESOLVED as follows:

- (a) To approve the amendment / modifications to the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations of the University as per Annexure 'A'.

(b) That the Section I of the Report on General Recommendations be examined by the University separately and the Report be placed before the next Academic Council.

(c) That Rule RU-2 be kept in abeyance pending receipt of the re-employment rules from the UGC. Marginal cases for re-employment may be considered for 1 (one) year in consultation with the Department concerned.

The Council further RESOLVED that (1) clarification be sought from MHRD/UGC on the cases of those Group 'A' Officers, like Engineers and Medical Officers who are not treated as teachers or other academic staff.

- (2) Clarification also be sought from UGC/MHRD about the qualifications of Principals.

- (3) Comprehensive amendment, including the existing points and those proposed for amendment be made before being sent to MHRD.

- (i) Admission to 2nd Year Class of Degree Part-I.
