MINUTES OF THE SEVENTYFIRST MEETING OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL

The 71st meeting of the Academic Council was held on the 17th & 18th June' 2004 at 10:00 Hours in the Science Seminar Hall at NEHU, Permanent Campus, Shillong.

MEMBER PRESENT

Professor J.B.Bhattacharjee, Vice-Chancellor (Acting), Chaired the meeting in absence of the Vice-Chancellor who was on leave.

WELCOME

The chairman welcomed all the members and introduced the new members to the Council .

The Chairman informed the house about a letter he had just received from Professor Manorama Sharma. With permission of the Chair, Professor Sharma then told the house about the letter she received from the Registrar informing her that the members on sabbatical leave are not supposed to attend the Council. She expressed her anguish over the letter, stated that as per her information some members on such leave in the past had attended meeting of the Council, wanted to be informed about the rule under which a member on sabbatical leave is prevented from attending the Council, expected the house to decide the matter in the interest of the University, and then left the meeting informing the house that she will be available in her department. This was followed by a prolonged discussion on the subject in which several member participated. It was observed that there is no specific provision in Statute or Ordinance on the matter, though there are instances of both allowing and not allowing the members on sabbatical leave to attend. The members also felt that the matter should be decided once for all. The Chairman assured the Council that a Committee will go into the matter and its report will be placed in the next meeting of the Council. In the meantime , the bonafide members shall not be prevented from attending the meeting; however, the onus of proof of bonafidy shall rest with the member concerned.

As regards other proposals, it was decided to read those along with the relevant items in the agenda.

1. Synod College	Renewal of Provisional Affiliation in Zoology (Hons.) for a period of three years and Hons. in Geography for one year subject to the condition that the college should appoint two more teachers in Geography. The College will be re-inspected after the conditions have been fulfilled.
2. Seng Khasi College	Renewal of Provisional Affiliation in Economic (Hons.) for a period of three years. Before the next Academic session one more Lecturer should be appointed.
3. Ladykeane College	Renewal of Provisional Affiliation for a period of three years in B.A.Sociology (Pass and Hons.) and B.Sc (Hons) in Bio-Chemistry.
4. Umshyrpi College	Renewal of Provisional Affiliation for B.A (Pass) in English, History, Sociology, Pol. 


