5:1 Statute, Ordinances, Regulations & Rules.

- (i) Ordinance on advertisement of vacancies for the teaching posts-Report of the Committee.

In pursuance of Resolution No:EC:95:97:6:7(1) adopted at the 95th meeting of the Executive Council held on 10.12.97, a Committee was constituted to examine the Ordinance on advertisement of vacancies for the teaching posts on the direction of the Visitor as conveyed by the Ministry of Human Resource Development.

The Committee met on 4th April,1998 and submitted its report which is placed at Annexure'A' for consideration of the Council.

MINUTES OF THE EC SUB-COMMITTEE

As per notification No:EC:95-4/Conf/97/537 dated 20.12.97, a committee was constituted to examine the Ordinance on advertisement of vacancies for teaching posts, along with the directive of the Visitor as conveyed by the Ministry of Human Resource Development vide their letter dated 11th November, 1997. The Committee met on 4th April, 1998, deliberated on the issue and decided as follows:

1. The amendment to clause 2(1) of the ordinance OE-4 on notification of vacancies by the Executive Council vide resolution No:EC:84:94:6:7(iii) in its meeting held on 8.12.94 was made as a measure of economy' to limit the advertisement in only few papers due to UGC directive at that time. As of now, those conditions by UGC are perhaps no longer applicable to the best knowledge of the committee members.
2. This matter was also considered by the 56th meeting of the Academic Council held on 21st and 22nd November, 1997 which resolved that "the posts may be advertised in four national news papers as well as in the regional news papers as laid down in the original ordinance, and the advertisement may also be sent to the University News as well".
3. While suspending the proposed amendment in the clause 2(1) of the ordinance OE-4 as suggested in the 84th EC meeting held on 8.12.94, the visitor as per letter No:F.8-32/97-Desk(U) dated 11.11.97 by MHRD, New Delhi has also advised that nation wide publicity to the vacancy positions is necessary to draw the talent from across the country for the growth of NEHU as a centre of excellence".

In light of the above, the committee recommends that.

1. The amendment to the clause 2(1) of the Ordinance OE-4 vide EC resolution No:EC:84:94:6:7(iii) dated 8.12.94 be annulled.

2. The advertisement for notification of vacancies should also be sent to the University News, over and above those provisions stated in the original ordinance OE-4, clause 2(1)
3. Positions which are earmarked under reservation categories must be advertised by specifying reservation category against vacancy notification after due approval from the Academic Council.
4. However, University may still economise expenditure on this budget head by sending the advertisement notification to the news papers in tabular format in small fonts. This task can be entrusted to NEHU publication Cell who have necessary infrastructure.
