

(xv) Revised rates of remuneration for payment to the employees of State Bank of India and Treasury Office.

The Deputy Registrar Mizoram Campus has informed that the Government of Mizoram has revised the rates of remuneration for the Treasury Staff with effect from October 1997 (copy enclosed at annexure-1) and that the staff of the Treasury Office Aizawl who were involved in the safe custody of confidential papers for the Under Graduate Examination 1999 have submitted their claims in accordance with the revised rates of the Government.

The existing rate for payment of remuneration of the University is Rs.50/- per session and as per the revised rate is Rs.100/- per day.

As the staff of the Treasury Office Aizawl and all other employees of State Bank of India of other centres have also been giving full cooperation all along, the Vice-Chancellor had approved payment of remuneration at the revised rate for similar function.

The matter was reported to the 61st meeting of the Academic Council and the Council RESOLVED to ratify the action taken.
