



"Nos AC 47:93:05(ii)-The Council RESOLVED to delete the existing provisions of Clauses 3(c) and 9 and of the notes below Clauses 3(b) and (d). The Council further RESOLVED to amend the provisions of Clause 7 to stipulate that- The pass marks required for each paper will be 35% ".
2. In resolution No: AC 48:94:5:01:(1) concerning the amendment/ updating of Ordinances OA-1, OA-2, OA-3 and OA-4, the word "B Department of Education" may please be added under the "VI School of Humanities and Education".

1. The Council RESOLVED that there was a need for re-organisation and re-designation of the Schools and on the assignment of Departments/Centres thereto.

2. The Council also RESOLVED that the present single Department/Centre Schools are to be abolished.

3. In the proposed structure of the Schools each School should have at least 3 and upto 7 (seven) Departments within it.

4. All the Centres of the University may together form one School.

5. Departments/Centres to be assigned to the Schools may consist only of the existing Departments/Centres.

6. (A). The nomenclature of the following proposed Schools has been approved :

- (i) School of Agricultural Sciences and Forestry.
- (ii) School of Economics & Resource Management.
- (iii) School of Life Sciences.
- (iv) School of Physical Sciences.
- (v) School of Social Sciences and
- (vi) School of Human: and Environmental Sciences.

(B) : For the School for Centres the Nomenclature is to be recommended by a Committee appointed for the purpose.

(C) : For the School of Humanities, Languages, Education and Information Sciences, the grouping of Schools and the nomenclatures of the Schools so grouped are to be recommended by the same Committee.

The Council also RESOLVED that the same committee alongwith some other members who may be appointed by the Vice-Chancellor to look into these structures, the assignment of existing Departments/Centres to these Schools.

5:2 : Syllabus.

(i) Proposed Syllabus of M.Sc. Forestry.

No.AC:47:93:5:02:(i): The Council considered the proposed Syllabus of M.Sc. Forestry and RESOLVED that the same be approved but the lists of suggested readings be improved upon and Research Project be nomenclatured as Project Work.

No:AC:47:93:5:02:(ii) The Council considered the revised syllabus for M.A.(Khasi) and RESOLVED to approve the same. The Council also noted that for Course II in the 2nd paper for Poetry the Book selected at Sl.8 is "Ka Jing Shai Ka Ri Khasi".

(iii) Proposal for certain changes in the Syllabus and Course Structure in Mizo.

No:AC:47:93:5:02:(iii) The Council considered the changes in the syllabus and Course structure proposed by the BUGS in Mizo for the ITDC and RESOLVED to approve the same.

(iv) Revision of Syllabus of M.Lib in Library and Information Sciences.

#### 5:3 Research

(i) Modification of the title of Research-provisions of Clause 5 (1) of Ordinance OC-4.

No:AC:47:93:5:03:(i): The Council considered the revision made to it by the Board of Research Studies in Sciences regarding condonation of the time limit with regard to modification of topic of research and RESOLVED that the respective Board of Research Studies may decide on individual case depending on the merit of each case.

- (ii) Request for extension of time to reply to the examiner's queries--case of Smti. Streamlet Dkhar, Department of Khasi.

No:AC:47:93:5:03:(ii) The Council considered the question of extension of time to reply to the examiner's queries in respect of Ms. Streamlet Dkhar, Department of Khasi and RESOLVED to authorise the Vice-Chancellor to examine the matter and the time-bar may be waived as a very special case not to be quoted as a precedent.

- (iii) Proposal for exemption of University employees from the bar to undertake employment while pursuing research for Ph.D. Degree.

No:AC:47:93:5:03:(iii) The Council considered the question of exemption of University employees from the bar to undertake employment while pursuing research for Ph.D. Degree and deferred the matter since the comments of all the Schools were not available.

5:5 Examination matters.

- (i) Central Evaluation.

No:AC:47:93:5:05:(i) The Council considered the discontinuation of the process of Central evaluation and RESOLVED that in view of its academic merits the same may be continued for P.U.(Science) and P.U.(Commerce) finals since most of the students in these two streams go for further studies outside this University. The Council further, resolved that the central scrutiny for these courses should also continue.

- (ii) Relaxation of qualifying period of service to become an examiner.

No:AC:47:93:5:05:(ii) The Council considered proposal from the relaxation of qualifying period of service to qualify as an examiner in view of the paucity in the number of examiners and RESOLVED that the qualifying period of service may be reduced as under.

1. One year service to become an examiner for P.U. Scripts.
2. Three years service to become an examiner for the

Degree Scripts.

3. Five years teaching experience at Honours/Major level to become an examiner for Honours level Scripts/Practicals.

- (iii) Qualifying in an optional paper "Linguistics" - case of 2 candidates from the Department of Khasi.

No.AC:47:93:5:05:(iii): The Council considered the question of allowing the scripts of 1. Bygrace Riplang and 2. Sukjai Swer of M.A. in Khasi evaluated for having appeared as additional optional paper in Linguistics. The Council RESOLVED that since the candidates concerned had already passed out in M.A. Khasi the question of evaluating the additional paper does not arise.

- (iv) Proposal of the BUGS(Local) in Zoology for centralisation of the Practical Examinations for Major.

NO.AC:47:93:5:05:(iv):The Council considered the proposal of the Local Board of Under-Graduate Studies in Zoology for centralisation of the practical examinations for major course and RESOLVED that since the proposal is not feasible, status quo be maintained. However, instead of one examiner, two examiners may be appointed for the purpose.

- (v) Proposal to abolish the existing principle of giving 25% weightage for sessional work in the P.G. Programme.

No. AC:47:93:5:05:(v): The Council considered the question of doing away with the principle of giving 25% weightage for sessional work in the P.G. programmes which was referred back to it by the Executive Council and RESOLVED that the 25% weightage may be continued and the marks awarded may be moderated by each Department. However, the principle of having minimum marks may be done away with.

- (vi) Proposal for enhancement of the rate for evaluation of answer scripts for Degree examinations.

No.AC:47:93:5:05:(vi): The Council considered the enhancement of rate for evaluation of answer scripts for Degree examinations and RESOLVED that the rates may be enhanced from Rs.3 to Rs.4.50/- per script.

No.AC:47:93:5:06:(ii): The Council considered the feasibility of providing admission to private candidates in the Post Graduate Programmes of Social Scs. and Humanities and RESOLVED that a project proposal for one ~~or~~ two Departments. be made in consultation with<sup>the</sup>/Department identified for the purpose to begin with and be submitted to the U.G.C. for necessary funds.

5:7 :Affiliation.

- (i) Provisional Affiliation of Upper Shillong College and Phek College, Nagaland.

No.AC:47:93:5:07:(i): The Council considered the provisional affiliation of Upper Shillong College and Phek College and RESOLVED that both the Colleges may be granted provisional affiliation for a period of three years subject to fulfilment of the conditions laid down by the respective Inspection Teams.
