(ii) Establishment of New Law College.

The 15th Affiliation Committee held on 23.6.97 considered the application of LALDINGPUIA LAW COLLEGE and decided to send an Inspection Tea, Accordingly an Inspection Team was constituted and inspected the College.

The Inspection Team recommended for opening a new Law College in view of the growing population and increasing public demand for more Seats in the Law College.

The matter was considered in the 56th meeting of the Academic Council held on 21st and 22nd November, 1997 which resolved to approve the same.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The college is located in the southern part of the Aizawl Town and it covers a very wide catchment area. In view of the growing population and increasing public demand for more seats in the law colleges, the opening of a new land college is fully justified. Moreover, the college has been able to attract more qualified teachers than the existing one.

The informations contained above, conform to the requirements laid down by the Bar Council of India, to the best of our knowledge. Only relaxation is sought for the 4th teacher, who is having 7 yrs. experience at BAR instead of the required 10 yrs as stipulated by the BAR Council for non LL.M. degree-holders.

The members of the NEHU Inspection Team visited the college on 14.10.97 at 3 p.m. Provisional Affiliation for three years is recommended.
