**Agenda for Academic Council****Re-evaluation of Post Graduate, BTech and BA LLB answer scripts**

The 84<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council vide resolution No. AC 84-10/10-5-1(vi) constituted a Committee to formulate guideline for re-evaluation of answer scripts. The same was notified vide Notification No. AC 84-4/Conf/2010-946 dated 2-12-2010 for which the Committee under the Chairmanship of Professor B.K. Mohapatra, Department of Geography met on 6<sup>th</sup> April 2011 in the office chamber of Controller of Examinations.

Further the Committee noted that reevaluation of answer scripts of PG and Professional Courses are being covered under the provisions of RC - 9 for UG courses. The Committee made the following recommendations:

***"in the absence of any regulation for reevaluation in respect of PG and Professional Courses and considering the fact that the University had since implemented the CBCS pattern of examinations at PG level and also semester system in the Professional Courses such as B.Tech and BA LLB, this facility of reevaluation may not be extended from the Academic Session 2011 onwards"***

Furthermore, the Examination Department is also faced with difficulties in undertaking reevaluation cases of PG courses in view of the fact that evaluations are being done internally.

However, an informal discussion was arranged between Pro-Vice Chancellor, Controller of Examinations and students representatives on 20<sup>th</sup> April 2011 to appraise the students about the University's view on reevaluation of PG, BTech and BA LLB answer scripts and possibility of discontinuation of this facility. In the informal discussion the students representatives sought time and agreed to provide feedback to Deputy Registrar (Examinations) in this regard which is still awaited.

The matter is now placed before the Council for consideration.

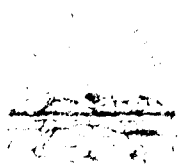

Draft**Miscellaneous Item from the College Development Council to be placed before the 85<sup>th</sup> Academic Council to be held on 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2011 :**

Pro Vice Chancellor's note No. 2-8/PVC/SH/NEHU/10-19 dated 2/5/2011, with reference to Ordinance OB-6 on the Affiliation of Colleges and subject of studies.

Ordinance OB-6 makes provision for the admission of Colleges/Institutions to the privileges of the University through, provisional/permanent/subject/course wise affiliation.

In relation to the above, OB-6 also provides for Inspection Team visits to Colleges/Institutions and submission of Inspection Report, recommending either 1 (one) / 2 (two) / 3 (three) year affiliation period, not exceeding 3 (three) years at a time.

Inconsistent recommendation of affiliation period largely is as a result of the facilities and fulfillment of requirements of the College at the time of inspection, which tends to impose on the financial resources of the University and its affiliated Colleges as well.

A. Guidelines for Provisional Affiliation:

In view of the above note, the affiliation granted to a College/Institution/subject/course may be for (i) 1 (one) year for Colleges/Institutions where several lacunae exist are observed and are required to fulfill mandatory norms/conditions as per University Ordinance/Regulations.

- (ii) 3 (three) years for Colleges/Institutions where to a large extent the mandatory norms/conditions as per University Ordinance/Regulations have been fulfilled/ are considered as negligible.

B. Mandatory enclosure of Reports of Inspection Team:

Communication from the CDC to the affiliated Colleges, conveying the decisions of the Academic Council has in addition extracts/recommendations of the Inspection Reports submitted by the Inspection Team to the University.

C. Circular to all Colleges to implement and adhere to UGC guidelines including qualification/recruitment procedures for teachers:

The CDC holds responsibility to send circulars to all affiliated Colleges under the University whenever necessary to implement and adhere to UGC guidelines, including qualification /recruitment procedures for teachers. The latest UGC regulations 2010 vide No. F.3-1/2009 dated 28/6/2010 on minimum qualification for appointment of teachers and other academic staff in Universities & Colleges and measures for the maintenance of standards in higher education, and revision of pay scales is in the process of being circulated to all affiliated Colleges under NEHU.

## Meghalaya Tribal Students' Coordination Committee NEHU

Subject: Procedures admission to Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Ph.D in NEHU.

Sir,

The Meghalaya Tribal Students' Coordination Committee, NEHU comprising of Khasi Students' Union (KSU), A'chik Post Graduate Students' Union (APGSU) and the Meghalaya Post Graduate Students' Union (MPGSU) has viewd with concern the way in which local indegenous tribals of the state of Meghalaya has been denied admission at different levels- Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Ph.D programme inspite of the fact that the NEHU mandate is for the promotion of the local tribal population. Based on the observations made in the past years, it may not be in correct to say that there has been anomalies, manipulation and preferential to others for obvious reasons. this has hurt the sentiments of the local indigenous students and if this trend continues, the student community will have no other alternative but to resort to corrective actions.

in view of the absence of proper procedure in the admission process, the Meghalaya Tribal Students' Cordination Committee, NEHU would like to put forward the following sugessions for your kind perusal and neccessary ction:

1. That in matters of admission at different levels- Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Ph.D programme, 50% of the vacancies in different departments should be reserved for indigenous students of Meghalaya and not for all NEHU products.
2. That for M.Phil and Ph.D programme there should be weightage of 10% to indigenous students of Meghalaya besides the weightage given to NEHU products.
3. That the weightage relating to Career marks for M.Phil and Ph.D programmes should be reduced from 50% to 20% since candidates comming from outside the state with liberal marking would not be in an advantageous position as compared to NEHU products where the evaluations process is comparatively restricted.
4. That sir, even if the UGC regulation is followed wherein written examination and interview is made madatory for admission to M.Phil and Ph.D programe, the same


should take in to consideration the familiarity of the subject concerned by candidates belonging to NEHU.

5. That the department who are conducting an entrance exam while taking admission, 50% must be considered from the career marks and 50% must be based from the entrance test.
6. That since the weightage marks is given for an ST student because of the status, so the same must be followed while a student shifting from one subject to the others.
7. That, the village illiteracy rate certificate issued by the BDO must be considered in the University Quota Resreve by giving 5% weightage.

In view of the above, we strongly appeal to you Sir, to kindly intervene in the matter and to ensure that the local indigenous students are not denied the rights which is due to them.

The President of NEHUSU informed the Pro-Vice-Chancellor that he could not attend the meeting due to other pre-occupations.

At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the members and called the meeting to order.

The Chairman also briefed the members about the purpose of the meeting.

The note of the Legal Officer to the Registrar dated 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2011, that he was not in a position to give his opinion pending additional information from the concerned section, was placed for the information of the Committee.

The letter from a Student Organization to the Vice-Chancellor for consideration of weightage/ reservation was thoroughly discussed. After thread-bare discussion the following resolutions were taken.


1. The Dean, School of Technology, informed the Committee that the lateral entry to B.Tech courses could be increased from the existing 5% ( five percent) to 10% (ten percent), for which they have already taken up agenda item with the Conference (Section), to be placed to the ensuing Academic Council. However, such admission has also to be based in the candidate's AIEEE score.

The committee decided to have a re-look to the University Calendar for admission to M.Phil /Ph.D Programmes, for which Ordinance OC-4 may perhaps require change.


To help the indigenous students of Meghalaya, it was unanimously resolved that 10 ( ten) more additional points be added to the Indigenous Students of Meghalaya for which changes in RC – 23 shall be required.


During the course of discussion on other academic matters it was unanimously resolved that the application form for admission to various courses must be signed by the candidate himself/herself. Further it was also resolved that the prospectus be suitably priced and 50% concession on price may be allowed to the students from SC & ST community.





The College applied for renewal of Provisional Affiliation for B. Sc. (Pass) in English, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Mathematics and B. Sc. (Hons) in Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Mathematics vide its letter no. SKDC/Ren.-Per. Aff/2011/Sc dated 4.3.2011. The Inspection Team constituted vide letter no. CDC/A.8/2004/Vol.II/1021 dated March 22, 2011 visited Sankardev College, Shillong on April 20, 2011 at 11.30. A.M. After perusal of all the relevant records and visit to the Departments of Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Mathematics for inspecting the facilities available with the respective Departments, the team noted the following:

1. The College has adequate number of classrooms for lectures.
2. The laboratory space in the Departments of Physics, Chemistry and Botany is adequate. However, the laboratory space in the Department of Zoology is not adequate. The lab. does not have proper workbenches for carrying out experiments.
3. The College does not have a Botanical garden. While a small net house facility has been created the same needs improvement as the mesh size of the net is too large. The department should also have a glasshouse.

### 5:7(ii) Miscellaneous Items:-

#### 1. **Permission for opening of a new Medical College :**

Establishing of a new Medical College, namely North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda and Homoeopathy (NEIAH), Shillong.

The above autonomous Institute under the Department of AYUSH, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has been established in Shillong with the approval of the Union Cabinet. The Institute will cater to the UG, PG and PhD in Ayurveda and Homoeopathy.

The Director, NEIAH has written to the Vice Chancellor vide letter dated 10/2/2011 to issue necessary consent of affiliation since the college is being established in Shillong.

The University has replied to the Institution vide letter dated 21/2/2011 informing that the Institute may apply for permission to open a new College/Institution and pay the prescribed fee and the matter be placed before the Academic Council for consideration.

#### 2. **Pro-Vice Chancellor's note No. 2-8/PVC/SH/NEHU/10-19 dated 2/5/2011, with reference to Ordinance OB-6 on the Affiliation of Colleges and subject of studies.**

Ordinance OB-6 makes provision for the admission of Colleges/Institutions to the privileges of the University through, provisional/permanent/subject/course wise affiliation.

In relation to the above, OB-6 also provides for Inspection Team visits to Colleges/Institutions and submission of Inspection Report, recommending either 1 (one) / 2 (two) / 3 (three) year affiliation period, not exceeding 3 (three) years at a time.

Inconsistent recommendation of affiliation period largely is as a result of the facilities and fulfillment of requirements of the College at the time of inspection, which tends to impose on the financial resources of the University and its affiliated Colleges as well.

#### A. Guidelines for Provisional Affiliation:

In view of the above note, the affiliation granted to a College/Institution/subject/course may be for (i) 1 (one) year for Colleges/Institutions where several lacunae exist are observed and are required to fulfill mandatory norms/conditions as per University Ordinance/Regulations.

(i) 3 (three) years for Colleges/Institutions where to a large extent the mandatory norms/conditions as per University Ordinance/Regulations have been fulfilled/ are considered as negligible.

B. Mandatory enclosure of Reports of Inspection Team:

Communication from the CDC to the affiliated Colleges, conveying the decisions of the Academic Council has in addition extracts/recommendations of the Inspection Reports submitted by the Inspection Team to the University.

C. Circular to all Colleges to implement and adhere to UGC guidelines including qualification/recruitment procedures for teachers:

The CDC holds responsibility to send circulars to all affiliated Colleges under the University whenever necessary to implement and adhere to UGC guidelines, including qualification /recruitment procedures for teachers. The latest UGC regulations 2010 vide No. F.3-1/2009 dated 28/6/2010 on minimum qualification for appointment of teachers and other academic staff in Universities & Colleges and measures for the maintenance of standards in higher education, and revision of pay scales is in the process of being circulated to all affiliated Colleges under NEHU.

The matter may be placed in the Academic Council for information and decision.

## **University Academic Calendar.**

Initially the Academic Council in its 79<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 30.5.2008 considered the Establishment of Uniform Academic Calendar in the Universities at National Level 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment to the UGC Regulation vide Resolution No:AC:79:2008:5:1:(iv), and it was taken up in the 80<sup>th</sup> Academic Council meeting held on 3.10.08 vide Resolution No:AC:80:2008:5:1:(v) and 81<sup>st</sup> Academic Council meeting held on 29.5.09. The amendment to Ordinance OC-15 on University Academic Calendar as per the UGC Regulation, 2008 was placed before the 81<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Council which Resolved to refer back the matter to the same Committee vide AC:81:2009:5:1: (xi) (a) & (b) . iv.	केंद्रीय माध्यमिक शिक्षा बोर्ड और केंद्रीय विश्वविद्यालयों द्वारा दिए जाने वाले छपे हुए प्रमाण पत्रों में खाली स्थान हिंदी में भी अवश्य भरे जाएं, इसके लिए रेल आरक्षण चार्टों की तरह हिंदी में भी काम करने वाले सॉफ्टवेयर मंगवा लिए जाएं।

Suggestion No. 2 To set up a Hindi Implementation Directorate in other Universities as established in University of Delhi and arrangement of Co-ordination may be with Hindi Committee/Academics of Hindi speaking states.

Reply : A separate fund will be desired from University Grants Commission, New Delhi for setting up a suggested Hindi Implementation Directorate.

Suggestion No. 3 : In the Universities where entrance Examination for admission is being held, arrangement of option of Hindi may be given in such examinations.

Reply : This subject will be placed before the Academic Council & Executive Council for consideration. A resolution has been passed by the Council that presently option of Hindi as optional in entrance examination will not be feasible. Although option of Hindi to reply in Hindi at the time of interview is available.

Suggestion No. 4. : Printed Certificate given by the Central Secondary Education Board and Central Universities blank space must be filled up in Hindi also. For this purpose Software like Railway Reservation chart may be installed.

Reply : Certificates given by the North Eastern Hill University is being prepared in bilingual form and hoping that we shall able to issue the Certificate in bilingual very shortly.
