

- (ix) Reimbursement of Medical expenses in respect of Mrs.S Chauhan, wife of Prof Y S Chauhan, Department of Botany.

The Executive Council vide resolution No:EC:90:96:6:6(x) resolved that the Finance Officer should study the case and submit his report to the Vice-Chancellor who is authorised to take a decision and report to the Executive Council regarding reimbursement of medical expenses in respect of Mrs Chauhan for Rs.5,259/- only against the claim of Rs.15,225.19 only. The drastic cut in the reimbursement was on account of the operation charge and the bed charges which are as follows :

In giving effect to the above resolution, Finance Department has written to the Director of Health services, Government of Bihar and the Christian Medical College and Hospital, Vellore to furnish the rate charged towards operation of fixation of a steel plate with nailing and also grafting of bone. However, reply from the above Hospitals have not yet been received. The Finance Department accordingly proposed to reimburse Rs.1,490/- instead of Rs.800/-(as already paid earlier), the rate charged by K.J.P.Synod Hospital, Shillong on account of operation and Rs.150/- per day in lieu of Rs.30/- towards bed charges the rate charged by the Civil Hospital for Private wards. Not satisfied with the above proposal of Finance Department, Prof Chauhan requested Finance Department that the same amount as reimbursed to Mrs A C Sinha be also reimbursed to him as it was a similar operation case. Alternatively, the rates prevailing in the CMC Vellore which is recognised by the University may be reimbursed to him whichever is lower. Since the Executive Council has resolved, vide resolution No:EC:66:89:6:6:(i) that the case of Mrs A C sinha should not be taken as a precedent in future cases and also since the rates of CMC Vellore is not readily available, the matter is therefore placed before the Executive Council for consideration and necessary orders.

(viii) Distinction between Full time casual workers and part time casual workers under NEHU.

No:EC:93:97:6:6:(viii): The Council considered the proposal to declare the normal working hours of casual workers as $6\frac{1}{2}$ hours per day and to classify them as full time casual workers and supercede its earlier decision of the 62nd meeting and RESOLVED to refer the matter to Finance and Internal Audit for thorough examinations.

(ix) Reimbursement of Medical expenses in respect of Mrs S Chauhan, wife of Prof Y S Chauhan, Department of Botany.

No:EC:93:97:6:6:(ix): The Council considered the grant of 100% reimbursement in respect of medical expenses incurred by Mrs S Chauhan, wife of Prof Y S Chauhan and RESOLVED that since the case was of an emergency nature the same may be sanctioned.

(x) Rationalisation of pay scale of Assistant Press Manager.

No:EC:93:97:6:6:(x) The Council considered the rationalisation of pay scale of the Assistant Press Manager and RESOLVED that the matter be referred to the Advisory Committee for Cadre Management and the Report of the same may be placed to the Council in its next meeting.

(xi) Payment of Leave Salary and Pension Contribution in respect of Prof M N Karna and release of increment regarding.

No:EC:93:97:6:6:(xi): The Council considered the release of increment of Prof M N Karna and RESOLVED that he should pay the leave salary and pension contribution due from him before the same can be considered.

(xii) Effective date of appointment in respect of Shri Devesh Walia, Lecturer, Geology, PUC, Aizawl.

No:EC:93:97:6:6:(xii) The Council considered the regularisation of the past services of Shri Devesh Walia, Lecturer in Geology, at PUC, Aizawl and RESOLVED that his services may be regularised with effect from 19.12.90 only.
