

Item No . 5:1 Statute, Ordinance etc.

(i) Amendment of UERU Statute/Ordinance.

No:AC:46:93:05:(i):The Council considered the proposal received from Prof. N.Hasan, as Dean School of Languages and RESOLVED that since a Dean is not competent to send agenda items to the Academic Council unless the matter has been discussed at the School level the agenda should be dropped.

(ii) Draft Ordinance on Professional Courses.

No:AC:46:93:05:(ii): The Council considered the Draft Ordinance of Professional Courses and RESOLVED to defer the matter to the next meeting of the Council.

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Item No. 5:2 Syllabus

(1) Proposed Syllabus of M.Sc Forestry.

No.AC:46:93:5:02(i): The Council considered the proposed syllabus for M.Sc in Forestry and RESOLVED that the syllabus may be sent back to the Board of Post-Graduate Studies for re-consideration of the following points and thereafter the matter may be placed before the Council for its consideration in its next meeting.

1. The term "credits" may be deleted.
2. The Council noted that the course content did not contain any aspects of global movement of forestry and North East Region. The Council, therefore, desired that such aspects should be incorporated in the course content.
3. The Admission criteria or eligibility has also not been spelt out. This may also be placed before the Council in its next meeting.

(ii) Detailed Course outline in respect of the papers on Teaching of Health and Physical Education.

No.AC:46:93:5:02: (ii): The Council considered the course outline of the Paper VI of the revised syllabus for B.Ed and RESOLVED to approve the same.

(iii) Proposal for revised restructured syllabi of Post-Graduate Diploma, M.A.(Regular and M.A. Via Diploma in Public Administration).

No.AC:46:93:5:02:(iii): The Council considered the revised structure of the syllabi for Post-Graduate Diploma, M.A.(Regular) and M.A. Via Diploma in Public Administration and RESOLVED that the matter may be referred back to the Board of Post-Graduate Studies/School Board with the following observations and thereafter be placed before the Council for its consideration at its next meeting.

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1. Course No.24 of the syllabus which has been listed as an optional paper in the fourth semester may be changed to one of the basic courses of the first semester
2. The Council noted that the text books listed for reference are too many in number and that the number of text books should be reduced to around five to ten books per course and the rest should be reference books.
3. The Council desired that the eligibility criteria of 55% marks in the III semester should be deleted for course No.25.

(iv) Bifurcation of P.U. Syllabi into 40:60 ratio.

No:AC:46:93:5:02:(iv): The Council considered the recommendations of expert Committee of the various streams and RESOLVED to approve the same. The Council further, RESOLVED to authorise the Vice-Chancellor to approve the recommendations in respect of Hindi, Telegu, Punjabi, Urdu, Manipuri, Bodo, Tenyidie, Latin, Arabic and Persian subject to ratification by the Council. The Council further, RESOLVED that the break up of marks should be 80:120 for the first Year and Second year respectively.

(v) Restructured Courses for papers in Mathematics for Economists, Mathematical Economics and Advance Statistical Mathematics-Three Year Degree Syllabus in Economics.

No:AC:46:93:5:02:(v): The Council RESOLVED to approve the restructured courses for the two papers for the Integrated Three Year Degree Course Economics-Mathematical Economics and Advance Statistical Methods.

5:3 - Research etc.

(i) Exemption of University employees from the bar to undertake employment while pursuing research for Ph.D Degree.

No:AC:46:93:5:03:(i): The Council considered the proposal of the Board of Research Studies in Sciences for exempting University employees from the bar to undertake employment while pursuing research for Ph.D Degree and RESOLVED that the matter be referred to the other Schools of Studies for consideration and be brought to the Academic Council thereafter.

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- (ii) Delay in Provisional Registration proposal for relaxation of the stipulated period for submission of thesis.

No.AC:46:93:5:03:(ii):The Council considered the condensation in delay of provisional registration in respect of those Ph.D scholars who were registered in 1992 and RESOLVED that the candidates may be allowed to submit their thesis before the lapse of the required two-year period subject to the satisfaction of the Vice-Chancellor that these candidates would have completed two years of study had the new Ordinance for Ph.D been implemented. Such candidates may be allowed to submit their thesis after 1993.

Item No. 5:5 Examination matters.

- (i) Fixation of rates for various application forms.

No.AC:46:93:5:05:(i): The Council considered the fixation of rates for various application forms of the examination Department and RESOLVED that Rs. 2/- for each form be charged and for the " permission form for Private candidates " for P.U. and Degree examinations, the rate be Rs. 5/-

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- (ii) Specification of marks and number of papers for the practical examinations in the Integrated Three Years Degree Course.

No:AC:46:93:5:05:(ii): The Council considered the specification of marks and the number of papers for the practical examinations of the Three Years Integrated Degree Course and RESOLVED to approve the recommendations made by the Committee appointed for the purpose and that Physics and Chemistry should also fall in line with the other subjects so that parity is maintained. It further RESOLVED that while there will be no objective type of questions for the major papers, there will be objective type of questions (40%) for the papers common to general stream.

5:6 - Establishment of new Deptt./Centres/Courses

- (i) Proposal of the Centre for Literary and Cultural Studies for starting a Certificate and Diploma Course in Folkloristics.

No:AC:46:93:5:06:(i): The Council considered the proposal of the Centre for Literary and Cultural Studies for starting a Certificate and Diploma Course in Folkloristics and RESOLVED to approve the same.

- (ii) Eligibility for admission to the Degree Course with Major-proposal of the Meghalaya College Principals Council for stipulating cut-off marks.

No:AC:46:93:5:06: (ii): The Council considered the proposal of the Meghalaya College Principals' Council for laying down the minimum eligibility marks for admission to the Integrated Three Years Degree Course Major Course and RESOLVED that the eligibility criteria should be open to the colleges as currently being done.

- (iii) Possibility of providing admission to private candidates for the Post-Graduate programmes in Social Sciences and Humanities.

No:AC:46:93:5:06:(iii): The Council considered the recommendations of the Committee appointed by it to work out the modalities for private candidates to the Post Graduate Courses and RESOLVED that the matter may be referred to the Director of the Distance Education who may comment on the feasibility of starting Post-Graduate courses through

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correspondence and the report of the Director, Distance Education may be placed before the Council at its next meeting.

5:7 - Affiliation, etc.

- (i) Affiliation of B.Sc (Pass Course) to Don Bosco College, Tura.

No:AC:46:93:5:07:(i): The Council considered the recommendations of the Inspection Team to allow Don Bosco College, Tura, to start the B.Sc (Pass Course) with effect from the 1992 session and RESOLVED that Provisional Affiliation for a period of three years may be granted subject to fulfillment of the requirements laid down by the Inspection Team.

- (ii) Extension of the term of provisional affiliation to NERIST for three years.

No:AC:46:93:5:07:(ii): The Council considered the extension of provisional affiliation to NERIST, Itanagar, for a period of three years and RESOLVED to approve the same.

iii) Grant for Affiliation

No:AC:46:93:5:07:(iii): The Council considered the proposals for grant of affiliation to the following colleges and RESOLVED that provisional affiliation for a period of three years may be granted subject to fulfillment of the requirements laid down by the Inspection Teams.

1. Hrangana College for starting Honours in English, Geography, Economics and History.
2. Lunlei Government College for starting Honours in Miz, English and Pre-University (Commerce).
3. Tikrkillla College for starting Bachelor of Arts (Pass Course).

5:8 - Other

- (i) Implementation of Five-Day week in the University. Item endorsed by the Executive Council.

No:AC:46:93:5:08:(i): The Council considered the introduction of Five-Day week and RESOLVED that the same may be introduced with effect from the

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next semester. The Council however, desired that a Committee may be appointed to look into the modalities for implementing the same. The Committee may consist of the following.

4. Dean, Students' Welfare
5. Registrar ----- Convener.

(ii) Identification of allied/cognate subjects for the Department of Forestry for composition of the Board of Post-Graduate Studies.

No:AC:46:93:5:08:(ii): The Council considered the identification of allied/cognate subjects for the Department of Forestry for composition of Board of Post-Graduate Studies and RESOLVED to approve the same.

(iii) Proposal for reservation of seats in each Post-Graduate Department for Children of employees with All India Transfer Liability and non-residents.

No:AC:46:93:5:08:(iii): The Council considered the proposal received from the University Grants Commission regarding the reservation of seats in the Post-Graduate Departments for children of employees with all India Transfer liability and non-residents and RESOLVED that the same may be accommodated under the Vice-Chancellor's discretionary quota.

(iv) Donation of Rs. 15,000/- by the President of India for instituting an award "The President of India Dr.Shankar Dayal Sharma Gold Medal".

No:AC:46:93:5:08:(iv): The Council considered the donation of Rs.15,000/- given by His Excellency Dr.Shankar Dayal Sharma, President of India, and RESOLVED to accept the same with appreciation and for which a Committee may be appointed to work out the modalities and frame the Ordinance for the purpose.

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Item No. 6 ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS -

6:2-Appointment/Creation-upgradation of posts/
Confirmation/ Extension/Option/Transfer
Release/Termination.

- (1) Report of the Committee on appointment of teachers from outlying campuses as Deans of Schools and Heads of Departments.

No:AC:46:93:6:02:(i): The Council considered the appointment of Head of the Departments and Deans of Schools from amongst the teachers from the outlying Campuses and RESOLVED that status quo may be maintained.

- (ii) Report of a Committee constituted under Academic Council Resolution No:AC:44-92:6:06:(iii) to consider promotional avenues for teachers.

No:AC:46:93:6:02:(ii): The Council considered the recommendations of the Committee appointed to look into the creation of promotional avenues for teachers and RESOLVED that :

1. Qualifications prescribed will be as laid down by the UGC for the purpose.
2. The scale of pay for the promotees will be as laid down by the University Grants Commission/Ministry of Human Resource Development. Promotees are however, eligible to apply for an open post whenever is it available.
3. The selection procedure to be followed will be the same as those laid down by the University Grants Commission/Ministry of Human Resource Development for the purpose.
4. The question of recovery of arrears of salary paid under the new scale of pay was deferred to the next meeting of the Council.

6:6 - Service Condition/Financial & Other Benefits

- (i) Partial modification on the minimum qualification prescribed for appointment of Lecturers.

No:AC:46:93:6:06:(i): The Council considered the partial modification on the qualification of lecturers and RESOLVED to accept the same.

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Item No. 8 ITEMS FROM THE CHAIR :


No:AC:46:93:8: (i); The Chairman pointed out to the Council that the School of Social Sciences in its meeting held on 23rd April, 1993 had approved that B.Sc students to be admitted to Anthropology Department may be awarded an M.Sc in Anthropology Degree while B.A students may be awarded an M.A in Anthropology Degree. The Council however, deferred taking a decision on the matter.

No:AC:46:93:8:(ii): The Council was informed that with effect from the next semester the common courses of Anthropology and Sociology would be bifurcated. The Council therefore approved the first and second semester of M.A courses in Sociology and the School Board should be informed of the decision.

No:AC :46:93:8:(iii) : A request was placed before the Council to allow Shri Huzo Meru, of the Department of Education, Nagaland Campus, to condone the late submission of his dissertation for M.A in Education beyond the period admissible. The Council however, did not accede to his request as it was beyond the provisions of the Ordinance.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair at 5:30 P.M.
