- (i) Framing of Statute on Procedure of Arbitration and Appeal-Report of the Committee.

The Committee appointed by the Executive Council vide Resolution No: EC: 91: 96: 6: 7: (ii) to frame the Statutes under Section 24(h) and (i) of the NEHU Act, 1973 met on 20th May, 1997 at 1100 hours in the Office Chamber of the Deputy Registrar (Conference). The following were present.

The Committee after thorough deliberations has framed the Statutes under Section 24(h) read with Sections 30(2) and 31(2) of the NEHU Act, 1973 on the procedure of arbitration and also a Statute under Section 24(i) read with Section 32 of the NEHU Act on the procedure of appeal, which are appended herewith at Annexure 'A' and 'B' for consideration of the Council.

PROCELURE OF ARBITRATION

Under Section 24(h) read with Section 30(2) & 31(2) of the NEHU Act, 1973.

- 1 (a) Any employee in dispute with the University arising out of the provision(s) of the contract of employment with the University as defined in Section 30(1) of the NEHU Act, 1973 may submit to the Registrar in writing for reference of the dispute to the Tribunal of Arbitration.
- (b) Any student or candidate for an examination in dispute with the University arising out of any disciplinary action taken against him or her by any Officer or authority of the University may submit to the Registrar in writing for reference of the dispute to the Tribunal of Arbitration.
- (c) Such submission should be made within 10 days of the receipt of such orders or copy of such resolution.
- 2 Upon receipt of the written submission for reference to the Tribunal for Arbitration the Registrar shall cause the constitution of the Tribunal of Arbitration as laid down under Section 30(2) of the NEHU Act, 1973.
3. The procedure to be followed by the Tribunal of Arbitration shall be as laid down in the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

PROCEDURE OF APPEAL

Under Section 24(i) read with Section 32
of the NEHU Act, 1973.

1. Any employee or student of the University or its constituent Colleges/Institutions who is aggrieved by a decision of any authority or officer of the University may represent to the Registrar through proper channel within 10 days of receipt of such orders or copy of such resolution clearly stating how he is affected by such a decision alongwith any documentary evidence on the matter supporting the representation.
2. The Registrar upon scrutiny of the representation shall forward the same to the Grievance Redressal Committee within 10 days of receipt of the representation to be constituted as per the Ordinances.
3. The Grievance Redressal Committee will submit its recommendation on the representation to the Registrar within 30 days of receipt of such a reference.
4. The report of the Grievance Redressal Committee may be placed before the next meeting of the Executive Council whose decision on the matter shall be final.

(xxiii) Extension of lien in respect of Dr. Jaminikanta Patanayak

(xxiv) Re-appointment of Prof.S.K.Mishra as Visiting Professor for a period of one year and appointment of Prof.R.K. Verma as Visiting Professor Hindi Department vice Prof.H.Tewari.
