

- (xvii) Amendment of qualifications for appointment of teachers in Universities.

The UGC vide its letter No:F.1-1/2002(ES) Examp dated 31st July,2002 at annexure-I has amended the minimum qualifications required for appointment of Lecturers and Career Advancement Scheme of teachers in Universities/institutions affiliated to it Regulation 2000, wherever the following para occurs :

"NET shall remain the compulsory requirement for appointment as Lecturer even for candidates having Ph D degree. However, the candidates who have completed M Phil degree or have submitted Ph D Thesis in the concerned subject upto 31st December'1993 are exempted from appearing in the NET examination"

It should be substituted with the following para :
"NET shall remain the compulsory requirement for appointment as Lecturer even for candidates having Ph D degree. However, the candidates who have completed M Phil degree by 31st December' 1993 or have submitted Ph D Thesis to the University in the concerned subject on or before 31st December'02 are exempted from appearing in the NET examination. In case such candidates fail to obtain Ph D degree, they shall have to pass the NET examination".

The UGC's modification has been approved by the Vice-Chancellor and it has been included in advertisement for Lecturer post. The action taken by the Vice-Chancellor was placed before the 68th meeting of the Academic Council for its ratification and the council ratified the same.

The matter is placed before the Council for ratification.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (e) & (g) of sub-section (1) of Section 26 read with Section 14 of University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956), and in supersession of the Regulations issued under University Grants Commission letter No.F.1-93/74(CPP) Part (v) dated 13th June, 1983, No.F.1-11/87(CPP) dated 19th September, 1991 and No. F.1-11/87(CPP) dated 21st June, 1995 and Notification No. 1-93/74(CP) dated 19th February, 1985, 26th November, 1985 and No.F.3-1/94(PS) dated 24th December, 1998 and UGC Regulations No.F.3-1/2000 (PS) dated 4/4/2000, the University Grants Commission hereby makes the following Regulations to amend the University Grants Commission (Minimum Qualifications required for the appointment and Career Advancement of teachers in Universities and Institutions affiliated to it) Regulation 2000, namely :-

1) Short title, Application and Commencement :

- (i) These regulations may be called University Grants Commission (Minimum Qualifications required for the appointment and Career Advancement of teachers in Universities and Institutions affiliated to it) (Ist Amendment), Regulation, 2002.
- (ii) They shall apply to every University established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, Provincial Act or a State Act, every institution including a constituent or an affiliated college recognized by the Commission, in consultation with the University concerned under Clause (f) of Section 2 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, and every institution deemed to be a University under Section 3 of the said Act.

(iii) They shall come into force with immediate effect.

In the University Grants Commission (Minimum Qualifications required for the appointment and Career Advancement of teachers in Universities and institutions affiliated to it) Regulation, 2000, wherever the following para occurs.

"NET shall remain the compulsory requirement for appointment as Lecturer even for candidates having Ph.D. degree, However, the Candidates who have completed M.Phil degree or have submitted Ph.D. thesis in the concerned subject upto 31st December, 1993 are exempted from appearing in the NET examination".

It should be substituted with the following para :

" NET shall remain the compulsory requirement for appointment as Lecturer even for candidates having Ph.D. Degree. However, the candidates who have completed M.Phil degree by 31st December, 1993 or have submitted Ph.D.thesis to the university in the concerned subject on or before 31st December, 2002 are exempted from appearing in the NET examination. In case such candidates fail to obtain Ph.D. degree, they shall have to pass the NET examination".

(xvii) Amendment of qualifications for appointment of teachers in Universities.

EC:114:2002:3:(xvii): The Council ratified the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in approving the amendment of qualifications for appointment of teachers in Universities as laid down by the UGC vide its letter No.F.1-1/2002/(PS) Exemp of 31st July, 2002.

“ NET shall remain the compulsory requirement for appointment as Lecturer even for candidates having Ph.D. Degree. However, the candidates who have completed M. Phil degree by 31st December, 1993 or have submitted Ph.D. Thesis to the University in the concerned subjects on or before 31st December, 2002 are exempted from appearing in the NET examination. In case such candidates fail to obtain Ph.D. Degree, they shall have to pass the NET examination”.

(xviii) Improvement facility for General and Honours candidates.

EC:114:2002:3:(xviii): The Council ratified the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in approving the improvement facility for General and Honours candidates.

“ Both for the General and Honours candidates, the facility for Improvement shall be extended only to those securing less than 45% marks in aggregate in one of the Elective Subjects concerned. If eligible, such candidates shall have to appear in all the concerned papers of the concerned subjects. For General all the three concerned papers and for Honours all the eight papers i.e., 5+3, irrespective of the marks obtained in each paper”. And

(for the students governed by the Annual System of Examination)

“ Improvement Facility shall be available under this system of examination. Such facility, shall, however, be permissible only after successful completion of final year examination. A student can appear for Improvement in any paper, irrespective of the marks obtained therein. Such facility, shall, however, be permissible only once and within a span of 5 (five) years from the date of admission into the first year class. This facility shall in no case be available beyond the fifth year. Under this facility, the student shall be given the benefit of Class/Division. However, the benefit of Ranking shall not be extended to them”.
