(viii) Appointment of Head, Centre for Supportive Learning System.

Dr. M.M.Singh was earlier appointed as Head, Centre for Science Education w.e.f. 11.11.1985 upto 8.9.98.

Consequent upon the framing of the Regulation on the Re-organisation of Centres of Studies, under Ordinance OA-3 and OA-11, as approved by the Academic Council in its resolution No.AC:57:98:5:6:(v) and the Executive Council resolution No.EC:97:98:5:1:(vii) the Science Education has been re-named as Unit for Science Education under Centre for Supportive Learning System and Prof. M.C.Pandey was appointed as Head, Centre for supportive Learning System for a period of 3 years. On the expiry of the term of Prof.M.C.Pandey, the 110th EC resolution No.EC:110:2001:6:26:(iv) appointed Prof.M.M.Singh as Head Centre for supportive Learning system for a period of 3 years. But in spite of the notification of the EC decision Prof.M.M.Singh has not taken over the Headship till date and Prof.M.C.Pandey continues as Head. (Annex-I)

Secondly, the Vice Chancellor, NEHU in terms of Regulation RA-9 under ordinance OA-3 and OA-11, has appointed Dr.D.Bhattacharjee as Teacher-Incharge of Unit for Science Education for a period of 3 years. But this arrangement could not be complied by Dr.D.Bhattacharjee as the Unit Incharge has not been handed over to him by Prof.M.M.Singh as in absence of any specific order for Unit incharge after re-organisation of centres, it was presumed that Prof.M.M.Singh continues as Unit-incharge.

In regard to his appointment as Head of Centre Prof.M.M.Singh, had called for certain clarifications at annexure-II like the objectives expectations, working procedures, etc related to the centres. The office had furnished the relevant informations of the notifications in regard to Re-organisation and Regulation on Centre of Studies, but Prof.M.M.Singh is yet to take over the Charge of Centre for Supportive Learning System.

ANNEXURE-I

Prof.M.M.Singh has commented vide Annexure-III that Dr.D.Bhattacharjee being new to the Centre, was yet under lot of stress for his unfair placement and therefore could not willingly accept to work for Science Education, even, under such circumstances, where in no one was available in the Centre. But this again contradicts to Dr.D.Bhattacharjee's letter at Annex-iv who has informed to know from whom should be taken the charge of the Unit incharge. But Dr.D.Bhattacharjee has finally taken over the charge of the unit-incharge of the Unit-incharge only w.e.f. 8.7.02.

The matter is therefore, placed before the council for decision.

Hon'ble Sir,

Namaskar! & Khublei!

With reference to the subject cited above, I am delighted beyond expression of words towards the reposed confidence in my efforts and me and to honour me with the designation of the Head CSLS and therefore thank you and the members of the Executive Council for the purpose.

Since it is a newly created Centre, on assuming the charge, I shall be obliged to discharge its regular responsibilities and assigned duties. Therefore it is imperative for me to know and understand the same fully.

More over, due to prevailing confusion experienced so far, during past three years for the complexity of problems associated with the functioning and performance of the Centres and CSLS in particular, for its being associated with three independently developed Academic Centres without clearly defined relationship, sharing of responsibilities and rationale, I sincerely believe that only the Executive Council can address the issue, and provide appropriate information, advise and working mechanism with assured commitment for its growth. therefore this requests for following clarifications and advise.

- Where is the Physical location of the Centre?
- What is its existing office and structure, infrastructural support (staff, academic, supportive, technical and secretarial facilities), financial provisions and obligations?

What is its locus standi viz plan, plan approved and the UGC recommendations?

What is its status with regard to the University Act, Statutes and the Ordinances?

What is its Genesis, Statutes of Objectives and Procedures and the University's expectations, commitments and determination for an effective performance?

What is the financial outlay, headwise for Space, Staff, Structures, Facilities and the Programmes for the growth of this Centre?

In the absence of any other regular Academic Colleague in the Centre, to whom I should hand over the responsibility of the regular activities of the Centre?

Further I believe in my capacity of being a member of the Academic Council and the Hon'ble Court it is my special obligation to invite your kind attention to the decisions taken by the hon'ble Executive and the Academic Council beyond their propriety and jurisdiction, completely ignoring the Act, Statute and Ordinances thereby attributing irregularity, illegitimacy, making the decisions void and almost impossible to implement thus causing utter confusion of non-resolvable nature.

Sir, You may kindly confirm from the constitutional documents that in no circumstance the structural change to the working Academic Units (Department and Centres) created by way of Ordinance, NEHU Act and Statute does not provide for the same.

Thus, the structure of Centre for Science Education, Centre for Distance Education, Centre for Adult & Continuing Education, Centre for Literary and Cultural Studies and Centre for Creative Arts cannot be altered by way of creating another Ordinance. It can be qualified legally illegitimate and void. However, there is qualified procedure for closing the Academic Unit (Centres & Departments) not by change of Ordinance but by Statute, which is yet to be formulated.

I am serious and earnestly keen to honour the EC's decision conveyed to me by way of a notification of the Deputy Registrar by taking over the charge and prepare myself to shoulder the responsibility for which I look forward to your clarifications and advise.

Kindly oblige by soliciting early response point-wise.
