

ii) Promotion in respect of
Medical Officers.

The 98th E.C. held on 15.9.98(Annexure-I) had resolved that para 9 of the Tikku Committee Report (Annexure-II) be applied to NEHU Medical Officers and posts so converted be made personal and Medical Officers with six years in the scale of Rs.3700-5000(pre-revised) or total eight years of service in the scale of Rs.3000-5000/- & Rs.3700-5000/- are eligible for placement in the next scale of pay Rs.4500-5700/-(pre-revised) (revised Rs.14,300-18,300).

Accordingly 4 (four) Medical Officers Dr.(Mrs) M. Synrem, Dr. I. Hussain, Dr.V.S.V. Prasad and Dr. D.K. Bahali were found eligible for placement in the next higher scale of pay Rs.4500-5700(pre-revised) (revised Rs.14,300-18,300) under para 9 of the Tikku Report, and Dr.(Mrs) M. Marwein for promotion to Sr. Medical Officer Grade II in the pay scale of Rs.10,000-15,200/-. on completion of 5 yrs in the post as similarly implemented in the case of 5(five) M.Os vide EC resolution NO:EC:73:91:6:02:(iii).

The matter was placed before the D.P.C. meeting held on 28.9.2000 for consideration and the minutes of the D.P.C. meeting is to be tabled by the Chair.

The matter is placed before the E.C. for placement/promotion.

ANNEXURE - I

(xiv) Conversion of Medical Officer's post to that of C.M.O.

EC:98:98:6:6:(xiv): The Council considered the conversion of Medical Officer's post to that of Chief Medical Officer and RESOLVED that para 9 of the Tikku Committee Report be applied to NEHU Medical Officers and posts so converted be made personal. The University Grants Commission be informed of those along with financial implications as called for.

ANNEXURE-IITikku Committee Report

(9) In all the three sub-cadres, (Teaching, non-teaching, and Public Health), Officers with six years service in the scale of Rs.3700-5000, or total 8 years service in the scales Rs.3000-5000 and Rs.3700-5000 and Rs.3700-5000, shall be placed in the scale of Rs.4500-5700 according to existing guidelines (which inter-alia, provide for overall good performance and at least two "verygood" assessment during the preceding 5 years). On such placement in the scale of Rs.4500-5700, the Associate professors, and the Specialists Grade II officers (non-teaching and Public Health) shall stand designated as Specialists Grade I Officers.

6:6- Service Condition / Financial & Other Benefits.

(i) Extension of the benefit of One-Upward Movement Scheme beyond 31.12.1993.

(iii) The higher pay drawn by a junior on account of earlier officiating in the higher post is not an anomaly requiring the stepping up of the pay of senior.

EC:108:2000:6:6:(iii): The Council considered the grant of remuneration to staff performing the duties of a senior during his absence and RESOLVED as follows:

1. For a vacancy beyond 45 days and upto 180 days the vacancy may be filled up on the basis of seniority-cum-merit in the Department / Section.
2. For a vacancy beyond 180 days it shall be filled up on the basis of the overall seniority in the University.
