

(ITEM FROM THE CHAIR)

- (ii) Approval of the recommendation of the Selection Committee for appointment to the post of Registrar.

Consequent upon the reversion of Shri. P.S. Rynjah ( who was appointed by the University as Registrar on deputation terms) to his parent department (i.e. Govt. of Meghalaya), the post was lying vacant since 4.8.98. The office of the Registrar was being looked after by Dr. Anthony Patton, Controller of Examination upto 2.10.99. At present, the office is being looked after by Shri. L. Nampui, Finance Officer, in addition to his normal duties.

To fill the vacant position by a regular incumbent, advertisement inviting applications was made in all leading Newspapers (both All India and Regional). Out of the applications received, only 4 (four) candidates were found suitable for consideration. Accordingly, a Selection Committee, as prescribed in the Statute was constituted as follows:
