

- (iv) Enhancement of Daily allowance for Students from Rs.40/- (Rupees forty) only to Rs.70/- (Rupees seventy) Only per day per student.

The Dean Students Welfare has forwarded the Application of the NEHUSU and other Departments and requested to enhance the rate of Daily allowance payable to the students while on study tour from Rs.40/- to Rs.100/-. The present rate of Rs40/- per day-per students is considered to meagre to meet the daily expenses as there is a hike in the price of all essential items. In the similar case the Finance Committee has recently enhance the DA rate payable to sport students from Rs40/- per day to Rs70/- per day per student. It is therefore proposed that the DA payable to students on study tour may also be enhanced to Rs70/- per day per student.

The matter was placed before the 62nd meeting of the Academic Council and the Council Resolved to approve the same and further authorised the Vice-Chancellor to constitute a Committee to look into the Enhancement of examination, hostel and other fees payable by students.
