

- (xv) Technical resignation in respect of Dr.G.D.Sharma, Reader, Deptt.of Botany.

The Executive Council vide resolution NO:EC:90:96:3:(i) ratified the action ~~xx~~ taken in granting lien to Dr.G.D.Sharma for one year w.e.f 28.5.96(AN) to enable him to take up an assignment as Professor of Life Sciences at Assam University. Before the expiry of the one year lien period, the Vice-Chancellor, Assam University vide his letter dated 11.4.97 requested the NEHU for extension of Dr.G.D.Sharma's lien for another period of one year to help the new University. The Executive Council vide resolution No:EC:93:97:3:(xv) approved the extension of lien for a period of one year w.e.f 28.5.97, afterwhich it was decided that he should either revert within the said period or resign on the expiry of the lien.

Thereafter on his request the lien was further extended again for the 3rd term & approved vide EC:96:98:2:(ix) which RESOLVED that extension of lien be granted for a period of one year w.e.f 29.5.98, however his lien will stand terminated if he is confirmed in the post at Assam University. Before the completion of the 3rd term Dr.G.D.Sharma vide his letter dt.17.5.99(Annexure-A) again requested for extension of lien for another six months w.e.f 28.5.99 which was endorsed by the Vice-Chancellor, Assam University, vide letter dt. 28.5.99(Annexure-B). In this connection, and as per GOI rule under JM.No.60/87/63-Estt(i) dated 14.7.67, there is no provision beyond the 3rd term and besides the Head Department of Botany, had been intimated that the teaching work is suffering due to non-filling up of the vacant position. Hence, the request for further extension was regretted and informed him vide letter dt.21.6.99 at Annexure-C, to join immediately without any delay. But Dr.G.D.Sharma did not comply to the office letter quoted above and remained silent. After reminders were issued to him vide letters dt.16.8.99 & 22.9.99 informing him to report within 1.10.99, failing which the post will be deemed to have been vacated. Dr.G.D.Sharma sent a FAX Message forwarded by the Vice-Chancellor Assam University dt.28.9.99 requesting for extension of lien or if not possible whether the letter be treated as Technical Resignation -(Annexure-D). Since no extension been granted by the NEHU beyond 28.5.99 and that the Assam University has ~~not~~ also not yet intimated his confirmation at Assam University. His resignation may therefore be considered for acceptance w.e.f the date of release i.e 28.5.96(AN) and treat the resignation as technical formality with the benefit of past services be allowed for transfer in the new post. This is in accordance to rule 26 of CCS Pension Rules, GOI OM NO.28034/25/87-Estt(A) dt.11.2.88.

The matter is placed before the Council for its decision.
