

- (iv) - LEAVE CASE OF DR.R.KHONGSDIER,LECTURER
IN ANTHROPOLOGY.

Dr. R.Khongsdier,Lecturer in Anthropology
Department submitted leave application routed through the H.O.D.
requesting for grant of Earned Leave for 14 days wef:24/2/98
to 9/3/98 and Leave Not Due for 25 days wef: 10/3/98 to 2/4/98
to escort his 6(six) years old daughter for medical treatment
at C.M.C. Vellore as approved by the SMO .. NEHU,Shillong.
Dr.R.Khongsdier is a newly appointed Lecturer & joined NEHU
on 1.5.1997 and is still under probation period of two years.
The leave standing at his credit as on 23/2/98 is EL wef:1-5-97
to 23-2-98 for 10 days and EL earned by Vacation Duty for 5 days
i.e. all total 15 days only in his credit.

In terms of provision to Cl-9(i) & sub-cl(ii)
of OE-6, teacher who is appointed on probation against substantive
permanent posts be treated as "Probationers" for the purpose
of granting Leave Not Due and leave not due shall not be granted
unless the VC is satisfied that as far as can reasonably be
foreseen, the teacher will return to duty on the expiry of the
Leave & Earn the leave granted.

In this connection, it is mentioned that
Dr.R.Khongsdier has since resumed his duties wef: 3/4/98 after
availing the said leave pending regularisation.

The matter is placed before the Executive Council
for consideration of the requested Leave Not Due
by Dr.R. Khongsdier.
