

(xi) Appointment of Dr.D.Bhorali as
Visiting Professor, Deptt. of
Commerce, NEHU.

The Head Department of Commerce, in his letter at Annexure - A, has requested for appointment of Dr.D.Bhorali (retd. Professor of Commerce, Gauhati University) as a Visiting Professor for a period of one year. The Head of Department stated that the Departmental meeting held on March 26, 2001, recommended the appointment on contract basis for a period of one year, in view of the urgent need of the Department and the sanctioned post under the IX Plan has not been filled up. The Dean School of Economics, Management and Information Sciences has approved the same. Therefore the Vice-Chancellor approved the appointment of Dr.D.Bhorali as Visiting Professor for a period of one year w.e.f 2.7.2001.

On the expiry of the above term, the Head of Department in his letter at Annexure - B, again requested for extension of the term of appointment as Visiting Professor for another period of one year in view of the fact that Prof.V.K.Kumar of the Department will proceed on Voluntary retirement w.e.f July 1, 2002, and the concerned teacher has agreed to help the Department for another one year. It may be added that the post of Professor have been advertised and could not be filled up and the Department has got only two Readers, and two Lecturers, therefore the Vice-Chancellor approved the appointment of Dr.D.Bhorali as Visiting Professor for another term of one year w.e.f 2.7.2002.

The matter is reported to the Council for ratification of the appointment as Visiting Professor w.e.f 2.7.2001 to 1.7.2002 and extension thereto w.e.f 2.7.2002 to 1.7.2003.

Sir,

I would like to inform you that at present Prof. D. Bhorali, Department of Commerce, Guwahati University, Guwahati has been requested to teach one course entitled C.203-Indian Financial System in the Second Semester, and he has kindly agreed to do it on a part-time basis. He comes every Saturday and takes three sessions and goes back to Guwahati. His appointment as a part-time Faculty Member has been sent to you, and I understand that it is being processed along with other cases. He is informed that he would be remunerated as per the rules of the University besides reimbursing travel expenses.

Prof. D. Bhorali is on extension at the Department of Commerce, Guwahati University, Guwahati, and he will be retiring on June 30th, 2001, after completing sixty three years. I have requested him to be with us initially for one year on a contract, and he has kindly agreed and submitted his biodata and last pay certificate. I am enclosing herewith those documents for your kind perusal.

I have discussed the matter in the meeting of the Department held on March 26th 2001 at 2 P.M., and it was agreed to recommend his appointment on a contract basis initially for one year in view of the fact that he is the seniormost professor in the entire North-East, excellent teacher, and has been helping the Department of Commerce, NEHU for the past fifteen years. The student feedback on his class-room performance is consistently good.

I have also discussed the matter with the Dean, School of Economics, Management and Information Science and this has his approval.

I may inform you that our sanctioned posts are not yet advertised, and this would take some time, and some more time to process, conduct interviews, and finally for the selected candidates to join. In view of all these, I request you kindly to consider the appointment of

Prof. D. Bhorali as a Professor in the Department of Commerce on a contract basis initially for one year with effect from July 1, 2001. This would give the department a great relief in organizing instruction. His association with the Department would give a big boost to the morale of the students in the Department. At present, I am given to understand by the Dean, Students Welfare, is quite low for a variety of reasons registered with him.

EC:113:2002:3:(xi): The Council ratified the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in appointing Dr. D. Bhorali as Visiting Professor in the Department of Commerce w.e.f. 2.7.2001 to 30.6.2003.

(xii) Enhancement of Examination, Hostel and other fees payable by students.

The Council, however, RESOLVED that since the Department is to be operated by teachers from the erstwhile SASARD and hence no funds from the X Plan would be required to meet the salary component, the quantum of grants for laboratory etc from the Plan should be allotted on the approval of the Academic Council and the Executive Council of the University. The Council also RESOLVED that the matter regarding the establishment of the Department and the assignment of the department to a school may be placed before the Academic Council and then the Executive Council for a decision.
