
5:1 Statutes/Ordinances/Regulations & Rules:

(i) Amendment to the Statute-2 relating to the emoluments, terms and conditions of service of the Vice-Chancellor.

NO:EC:148:2011:5:1:(i): The Council considered the letter from the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, Government vide No.F.1-23/2004-Desk-(U) of 3rd September, 2010 on amendment of Statute-2 relating to the emoluments, terms and conditions of service of the Vice-Chancellor of Banaras Hindu University by the President of India, in her capacity as the Visitor of the BHU who is pleased to remit an amendment to the Statute of BHU for consideration by the Executive Council. The President, in her capacity as the Visitor of North-Eastern Hill University is also pleased to remit an amendment to the Statute -2 relating to the emoluments, terms and conditions of service of the Vice-Chancellor of NEHU for consideration by the Executive Council.

As per the advisory from the Visitor, the Council accepted the amendment and **RESOLVED** that. NEHU should send the amended Statute to the Ministry of Human Resource Development for the formal approval of the Visitor.

The Council **RESOLVED** that in forwarding the Statute the advisory of the President of India who is also the Visitor of the University be included. The Council further **RESOLVED** that this Clause be added in the Ordinance relating to the Vice-Chancellor and it be sent to the Visitor for formal approval.

(i) Proposal for engagement of personnel on pro-rata Basis in NEHU, Tura Campus, Tura.

NO:EC:148:2011:6:2(i): The Council considered the proposal for engagement of the 12 personnel (presently employed on contract) on pro-rata basis in NEHU, Tura Campus, Tura, w.e.f. 1.10.2011 and the Council **RESOLVED** that salary be paid at the rate of Rs.8000/- p. m for a 6 -day working week and at the rate of Rs.6500/- p.m. for a 5-day working week. Payment shall be

made from XI Plan allocation for Tura Campus and on the basis of actual number of days of work. In view of the fact that the salary be paid against the allocation which is valid only upto 31.3.2012, the Council further **RESOLVED** that this decision will be reviewed during the XII Plan period. Out of the other 15 personnel to be hired, 11 are to be engaged as replacement for same number taken from outsourced personnel. They may be currently paid as above. However, 4 new personnel to be taken on are to be paid Rs.6000/- p.m. These also will be from XI Plan allocation for Tura Campus as per UGC sanction.




