

5:6: Establishment of New Depptts/Centres/Courses

(v) Diploma Course in Computer Application

The Academic Council in its 44th meeting held on 7th and 8th August, 1992, and the Executive Council in its 76th meeting held on 14th August, 1992 approved the introduction of a Diploma Course in Computer Application for Graduate provided the concerned institutions should obtain proper accreditation within a period of three years, from the Department of Electronics, Govt. of India.

The above decision was conveyed to the Principal, St. Anthony's College by the Controller of Examinations.

The Principal has recently vide letter at Annexure 'A' written to the Controller of Examinations that the College be exempted from going in for accreditation from the Department of Electronics.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

This has a reference to your Nos.DR/EX/MAC-91 dated 09-03-93 and No.COE/NEHU/Comp.Sc/92-3941 dated 1.11.93 regarding the approval of the Syllabus for PGDCA Course and affiliation of this College to run the Course.

As approved by the AC vide Resolution No:44:4:92:5:05:(V), the College was advised to obtain D.O.E. accreditation within 3 years.

In this connection may I point out the following:

1. All Colleges running PGDCA Course in other parts of the country are affiliated at Universities only. Only private institutes go in for accreditation by way of recognition.
2. Students value a Course affiliated to the University for more than any diploma by other agencies.
3. The Circular from CDC No.FC-16/90-91/286-341 dt.2.5.91 explicitly forbids Colleges affiliated to NEHU from running Courses under affiliation to other agencies or Universities.

Under the circumstances, the College may kindly be exempted from going in for accreditation to D.O.E. and may be allowed to continue with the PGDCA programme.
