

**6:3: Leave/Deputation**

- (i) **Grant of three years study leave in respect of Shri Juwesh Binong, Assistant Professor, Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering, School of Technology, NEHU, Shillong.**

**NO:EC:140:2010:6:3:(i):** The Council considered the grant of three years study leave in respect of Shri Juwesh Binong, Assistant Professor, Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering, School of Technology, NEHU, Shillong to pursue Ph.D. programme at Tezpur University and **RESOLVED** to grant Shri Binong study leave initially for a period of two years only in the first instance, extendable by one year more if there is adequate progress as reported by the research Guide.

**6:4: Disciplinary**

- (i) **Placement of two Civil Engineers, NEHU, under suspension.**

**NO:EC:140:2010:6:4:(i):** The Council considered the representations of the two Civil Engineers, NEHU, namely Shri W.R. Lyngdoh and Shri L.K. Rathaur under suspension w.e.f. 27<sup>th</sup> May, 2009. The two Engineers have submitted their representations to drop the charges against them and the suspension order be revoked. The Council **RESOLVED** to revoke the suspension order with a warning to the Engineers not to commit such mistakes in future. A similar warning be issued to Prof. R.N. Sharan.

- (ii) **Request for extension of time by the Chairperson, Women's Cell, relating to the case of Prof. V.K. Srivastava.**

**NO:EC:140:2010:6:4:(ii):** The Council considered the request of the Chairperson, Women's Cell, to complete the proceeding relating to the case of Prof. V.K. Srivastava, Department of Hindi, for extension of time as a 'matter of precaution' in case she is not able to complete the proceeding within the scheduled time till February, 2010 as per the decision of the 139<sup>th</sup> Executive Council meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> December, 2009. The Council considered extension of time due

to sad demise of her husband and agitation of employees at the University during December, 2009 and January, 2010. Based on these reasons, the Council **RESOLVED** to extend the time for completing the proceeding by the Women's Cell till end of March, 2010.

**6:6: Service Conditions/Financial & Other Benefits.**

**(i) Honorarium for Guest Lecturers.**

**NO:EC:140:2010:6:6:(i):** The Council considered the UGC guidelines vide Circular No.F.10-1/2009 (PS) dated 5.2.2010 that the Commission has accepted the recommendation of the VI Pay Review Committee on enhancement of honorarium of guest/part time teachers for appointment of guest/part time teachers etc., and the Council **RESOLVED** to accept the same **except** point No.3 which states 'Selection procedure for appointing Guest/Part time teachers should be the same as for a regularly appointed teachers'. The Council also **RESOLVED** that a clarification on this point be sought from the UGC as such appointments are made for short durations and following the procedures laid down by the UGC will not be feasible.

**(ii) Due and drawn statement in respect of Shri L.K. Rathaur, Junior Engineer in compliance with 137<sup>th</sup> Executive Council Resolution vide No:EC:137:2009:6:6: (iv)**

**NO:EC:140:2010:6:6:(ii):** The Council deliberated at length on the issue and **RESOLVED** to seek more information connected with all such Engineers before taking a decision. Further the Members **RESOLVED** that the matter be placed in the next meeting of the Executive Council

**(iii) Replacement of scale of pay in respect of University Engineer.**

**NO:EC:140:2010:6:6:(iii):** The Council considered the UGC's letter No.F.21-16/2008/(CU) of 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2008 and **RESOLVED** to accept the pay scale of Rs.14300-18300 for University Engineer. Further the Council **RESOLVED** that the amendment in Recruitment Rules be made accordingly.
