- (i) Allied and Cognate subjects for the Department of Hindi

Within the School

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.

Shillong Commerce College: Provisional Affiliation may be extended for a period of three years (1997-2000) and the College should install computers immediately .

Morning Star College: Provisional Affiliation may be extended for a period of one year from 1997-98 and the College is to fulfil all the requirements laid down by the Inspection Team within the year.

Jaintia Eastern College: Provisional affiliation for Elective Khasi and the College is to fulfil the requirements laid down by the Inspection Team.

Ri-Bhoi College: Provisional affiliation for a period of three years (1997-2000) subject to fulfilment of the conditions laid down by the Inspection Team.

Women's College: Permanent affiliation be granted.

B.B.S. College: Conditions laid down by the Inspection Team be fulfilled before Provisional Affiliation is granted.

Saitual College: Provisional Affiliation be granted for a period of three years for B.A. Pass in English, MIL, Political Science, History, Education, Economics, Mizo(Elective) and Honours in Political Science and History.

Synod College: Provisional Affiliation in Honours in Chemistry, Mathematics and Botany may be granted ; provisional affiliation in Physics Honours be granted subject to a follow-up inspection after a period of two years ; affiliation in Geography Honours deferred till adequate staff and infrastructure are available. Provisional affiliation in Zoology Honours be granted subject to the fulfilment of the requirement of teachers and infrastructure.

St. Edmunds College: Provisional Affiliation for Pass and Honours in Commerce be granted.
