

- ( ii) Bifurcation of reservation quota for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in admission to P.G. Courses and University hostels and in appointments etc.

In compliance to Government orders on reservation for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, the University, through the Executive Council, have passed various resolutions in respect of reservation for these communities in matters like appointment of teaching and non-teaching staff, allotment of staff quarters and reservation of seats for SC/ST students in admission to P.G. Courses and University Hostels. In each of these resolutions, separate quota each for SCs/STs has been clearly indicated, but reservations for SC & ST has been clubbed together for both the communities vide resolutions No.EC:90:96:5:8(2), No.EC:88:95:5:1(ii) & No.EC:45:85:04:2 ( i ).

It is desired by the Government, the National Commission for SC and ST, and the UGC, that reservation quota for SCs and STs in admission to P.G.Courses and Hostels, in all appointments be bifurcated forthwith.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration and review of the above E.C. resolutions as desired by the Government of India.

#### **5:8- Others**

##### **(i) Implementation of Five-Day Week in the University.**

EC:113:2002:5:8:(i): The Council considered the implementation of Five-day Week in the University and RESOLVED to approve the recommendation of the Academic Council. The Council, further, RESOLVED that the various Departments should send their Time-Tables to the Registrar for scrutiny.

##### **(ii) Bifurcation of reservation quota for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled tribes in admission to PG Courses and University Hostels and in appointments etc.**

EC:113:2002:5:8:(ii): The Council considered the bifurcation of the reservation quota for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes for the purpose of appointments and RESOLVED that a University Level Roster may be maintained. However, for admissions due to the demographical structure of the region 50% reservation would be made for SC and ST out of which 10% will be reserved for SC but would be dereserved to ST in case there are no Scheduled Castes applicants. The matter may, however, be first placed before the Academic Council for its recommendation.
