

iv) Selection Committee of Shillong Law College.

The Shillong Law College informed that 4 full time teacher including the principal were appointed out of which one did not join. It is not known in what way the teachers were appointed. It appears that no Selection Committee was constituted and the University was also not asked for nominating experts. In spite of several reminders, Principal, Shillong Law College has not furnished the information on:

- (i) Whether the Selection Committee was constituted.
- (ii) The details of qualifications, etc, of the teachers selected. The Principal simply forwarded the names of the full-time teachers appointed to this Office as
 1. Shri. H. Ahmed -(Principal)
 2. Shri K. Rahman
 3. Shri D.P. Chakraborty.

The Principal has also not informed the University whether all the full-time teachers are practising in the Court or not.

The Principal has forwarded the list of G.B. members newly constituted by the outgoing G.B. *at Annamur. A.*

The matter was placed before the 57th meeting of the Academic Council and the Council considered the Selection Committee of Shillong Law College and Resolved that the members of the Governing Body from the University should raise the issue as to how the Selection Committee was constituted.

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.
