**Subject :** (1) Revision of Rates of Remuneration for the officers/staff of the Government Treasury/Banks etc. for safe custody of confidential papers (Question Papers) relating to the undergraduate Examinations.

The University, *ab initio*, had been depending on the services of the Government Treasury Officers, Banks, etc. for safe custody of the confidential papers relating to the Undergraduate Examination on behalf of the University and Colleges, affiliated to this University.

The duties of the Officials for such assignments have been to ensure the following:

- (1) To ensure safe custody
- (2) To arrange the confidential papers datewise and sessionwise to ensure quick disposal.
- (3) To make available the Question Papers to the concerned colleges so as to reach the Examination Centres one hour before their commencement (i.e. 8AM).
- (4) For (3) above, the officials are required to be in position in their offices latest by 8 AM, requiring them to start their days much before their normal office hours.

For performance of the above functions outside their normal duties, *ab initio* the University has been paying remuneration rates which do not today at all commensurate with the task they are required to perform. A number of representations have been received towards enhancement of the existing rates, which due to oversight could not be considered alongwith the revision of rates earlier and have remained unrevised since 1983.

As a matter of fact, some of them have even refused to undertake such assignments but on the persuasion of the University, have conditionally accepted to oblige.

It is therefore felt necessary to enhance these rates in the interest of the University to the extent of rates proposed below:

<b>Officials</b>	<b>Existing Rate (In Rs.)</b>	<b>Proposed Rate (In Rs.)</b>
(a) Treasury Officers (T.O.)	10 per session	25 per session
(b) Persons assisting the T.O.	5 per session	20 per session
(c) Driver	nil	15 per session
(d) Chowkidar	nil	10 per session

It may be noted that the existing rates do not include a Driver and a Chowkidar. However, the Treasury Officers have been requesting that since the services of a Driver and a Chowkidar are very much involved in the performance of their duties, they too may be remunerated.

As the requests are genuine and moderate, the Executive Council may like to consider the proposal for approval.

- (xii) Appointment of Head, Centre for Applied Statistics, NEHU, Shillong.
