

(vi) Request for appointment on compassionate ground in Group-A level - case of Mrs. S. Chauhan.

Mrs Sharda Chauhan, wife of (Late) Prof. Y.S. Chauhan submitted an application dated 11.8.99 requesting for appointment on compassionate ground. Her application and bio-data is self-explanatory and placed at Annexure-A.

It may be stated that there is no provision in the NEHU Ordinance, Act and Statutes for appointment on compassionate grounds.

Under RE-3 of the NEHU Ordinance contract appointment to academic post is vested with the Executive Council and shall have the powers to make contract appointment against floating post and vacant post in the teaching cadre, namely, Professors, Readers and Lecturers for furthering the cause of academic life and programme of the University, provided that (5) such appointment shall be made from among the person of eminence and repute in the respective field and working abroad for a period not exceeding three years, provided further, that such appointment shall in no case in any of the regular post lying vacant in the cadre concerned. The appointment shall be initially for a period of two years, during which period, the appointee shall have an opportunity to seek employment against the regular post in the University, whereafter, he may look for appointment elsewhere. The contract may be renewed for another year but shall automatically stand terminated at the expiry of three years. Further, under Clause-4, RE-3, the appointment shall not be against a specified vacancy but shall depend on the merit, suitability and status of the person vis-avis, the requirement of the Department concerned. As per the bio-data of Mrs. S. Chauhan, she does not fulfill the qualifications laid down under Clause-4 (a) (i) and (ii) of RE-4 and neither she fulfills the qualification for appointment in any Group-A post (administrative post).

As per the Government of India Rules, Compassionate appointment can be considered only for Group-C and D and not for Group-A post, as Group-A post is also to be approved by the UGC for creation of a post.

Under the circumstances explained above and keeping in view that there is no sanctioned post to accommodate her in the Group-A post, and she neither fulfills the qualifications laid down by the UGC, the matter is placed before the Council for consideration on humanitarian ground.

Sir,

I had applied for a suitable placement in the University to tide over the difficult period of about five years subsequent to the sad demise of my husband, late Prof. Y.S. Chauhan. In this connection I have received a letter No.F.10-1/Estt.I/Apptt/92(Vol.II)-909 of July 13, 1999, from the A.R. (Estt.I) asking me to submit the application in the proper format for placement up to group C level post in this University. In this connection I would like to make the following submission:

1. That Sir, the then Vice-Chancellor had mentioned the possibility of a suitable placement commensurate with my qualifications.
2. Since I am M.A.,B.Ed., I feel I should be placed in a higher category post.
3. The restriction of group C/D should not be invoked in my case as I am not seeking employment on a permanent basis.
4. Please note that I would be satisfied with an adhoc or contractual appointment for a period of about five years, or the period that Professor Chauhan would have served this University.

In view of the above I would request you to kindly reconsider the stand of the University and place me in a post befitting my qualifications and status.
