

- (ii) Circular from the UGC regarding ban imposed on
(a) Creation of plan and non plan posts, (b) filling up of vacant posts, and (c) Purchase of new vehicle and instruction to carry out a thorough review of the vacant posts.

The U.G.C. vide D.O. letter No.F.7-8/99(CPP-II) dt. 31-8-99 has conveyed the directives of the Ministry of Finance regarding imposition of a ban on (a) Creation of plan and non-plan posts (b) filling up of vacant posts (c) Purchase of new vehicles, etc. and that these austerity measures shall be implemented with immediate effect, (copy of the letter is enclosed vide Annexure A and A¹).

Meanwhile, the Commission has also instructed that the University/College should undertake a review of all the posts which are lying vacant in the University and in the affiliated Colleges and subordinate office, in consultation with the UGC and will ensure that the review be completed at the earliest possible and full details of vacant posts in their respective University/College be made available.

Meanwhile, the said circular has been circulated to all concerned vide letter No.F.4-1/CRC/91-291 dt. 15-9-99 (vide Annexure B) for information.

The matter is placed before the E.C. for its kind appraisal and to consider the following.

1. To appoint Officer(s)/Committee to conduct the review of the vacant posts on the three Campuses of the University including PoU.C.

Dear Sir/Madam,

The Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, has circulated an Office Memorandum No.7(3)/E/(Coord)99 dated 5th August, 1999, with the direction that the following austerity measures shall be implemented with immediate effect by all the Institutes/Universities and the colleges affiliated to it.

All these measures are MANDATORY and are required to be implemented COMPULSORILY, with immediate effect. The Vice Chancellors/Registrars will be held personally responsible for non-compliance of these measure in universities and Principals in case of Colleges.

(1) Ban on creation of Plan and Non-Plan posts

The existing ban on creation of Non-Plan posts will continue and should be strictly enforced. Any unavoidable proposals for the creation of plan posts including Group 'B' 'C' and 'd' posts shall continue to be referred to the University Grants Commission for approval.

(2) Ban on filling up of vacant posts

Every University/College shall undertake a review of all the posts, which are lying vacant in the Universities and in the affiliated Colleges and subordinate offices, etc, in consultation with the University Grants Commission Financial Advisers will ensure that the review is completed in a time bound manner and full details of vacant posts in their respective Universities etc, are available. TILL THE REVIEW IS COMPLETED, NO VACANT POSTS SHALL BE FILLED UP EXCEPT WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION.

(3) Purchase of new vehicles

Purchase of new vehicles is banned until further orders. Exceptions will be allowed only for meeting the operational requirements of Defence, Central Para Military Forces

(4) Foreign Travel

Foreign travel funded by the Government of India, unless it is absolutely unavoidable, shall not be undertaken till the end of the current financial year.

The Universities are requested to bring this to the notice of all the Colleges affiliated to it, for strict compliance.

EC:104:99:6:7: (ii): This item was taken along with item No.6:2: (xvi): The Council considered the letter received from the UGC regarding banning on creation of Plan and non Plan-posts and filling of vacant posts. The Council considered the Ban but in view of all the difficulties faced by NEHU it is not possible to accept the ban as it stands. The Council suggested that a Committee be appointed to look into the matter, while reiterating its stand on it. The Vice-Chancellor shall constitute the Committee which will also look into the ban on purchase of vehicles.

- (iii) Realisation of quarter retention charge at the revised rate.

EC:104:99:6:7: (iii): The Council considered realisation of quarter retention charge due from Prof. JB Bhattacharjee while he was on deputation to Assam University and RESOLVED that since he has already paid Rs.1000/- per month towards retention of the quarter being the amount equivalent to the HRA admissible to him for the month preceding his deputation period the matter may be treated as closed.
