(1) Rajiv Gandhi Chair

The recommendation of the Search Committee for the Rajiv Gandhi Chair in NEMU was placed to the Executive Council ~~xxx~~ in its xxxxxx meeting held on 21st March, 1997. The Council RESOLVED as " The Council considered the recommendation of the Search Committee appointed to recommend names for the incumbent of Rajiv Gandhi Chair and RESOLVED that since the Search Committee could not recommend three names as required under Ordinance the matter may be referred to the Ministry of Human Resource Development, the University Grants Commission and the Rajiv Gandhi Foundation". The Ministry of Human Resource Development vide its D.O.No.F.8-14/97-Desk (U) dated 28th April, 1997 directed the University to undertake the exercise again to search an eminent scholar for the Chair. Accordingly, advertisement was made in the 'Statesman', the 'Hindus' and the 'Times of India'. In response, 11 more applications were received. This was in addition to the bio-datas received from 7 scholars in response to our earlier advertisement. The Search Committee in its meeting held on 6th September, 1997 considered the bio-data of the Scholars and submitted its report. The report and the bio-datas of the Candidate will be tabled by the Chair.

The Observer from the Ministry of Human Resource Development also attended the meeting but he was not in a position to spare time to go through the details of the bio-data submitted by 18 Scholars. He then requested the Chairman that the other two members of the Committee who are more conversant with the University affairs with Academic qualification may discuss the matter between themselves and he would go through the bio-datas later on and express his views including putting the proceedings in the appropriate legal form, if any. However, the Observer of the Ministry was contacted and he fixed 24th of September, 1997 as the date for going through the bio-data at New Delhi.

Since the Observer is not a member of the Committee and he could not fix a date for the purpose before the meeting of the Executive Council, the recommendation of the Search Committee is placed before the Executive Council for consideration.
