

(iii) Qualifications/experience for the post of Deputy Registrar in Central University.

The decision of the Executive Council in its 87th meeting held on 1st November, 1995 resolved as under,

NO:ED,87:95:6:2:(vi): After thorough deliberation on the matter, the Council RESOLVED to approve a ratio of 50:50 by promotion and by open recruitment for the post of Deputy Registrar and also to relax the Educational Qualification upto Bachelor's Degree for internal candidates and the University Grants Commission be moved to approve the same.

In furtherance of the 87th E.C. held on 1st November, 1995, the University has referred the matter to the U.G.C. vide our letter NO. F. 17-1/Estt-II(B)/92-325 dated 25th Jan. 1996 (Annexure - A) for approval of the same.

However, in reply to the U.G.C. vide its letter NO.F. 1-7/96(PS) dated 24th July, 1996 (Annexure- B) has stated that the minimum qualifications and ratio of 25% of Deputy Registrar by promotion and 75% of Deputy Registrar by direct recruitment cannot be relaxed. This means that the UGC has not agreed to the decision arrived at by the Executive Council in its 87th meeting as quoted above.

The matter is therefore, re-submitted before the Council for consideration and decision.
