- i) Renewal of Provisional Affiliation to Aizawl Law College-Report of the Inspection team.

The Inspection Team which Visited the College recommended Renewal of Provisional affiliation of the Aizawl Law College for 3 years. The Inspection Report is placed as Annexure-'A'.

The matter was placed before the 58th Academic Council meeting held on 10th September'1998. The Council resolved that extension of Provisional affiliation may be granted for a period of three years with effect from December'1996.

The matter is placed before the Council for Consideration.

The Bar council stipulates a minimum of four fulltime lecturers for a law college. The Aizawl Law College has 3 full time Lecturers including the Principal. A number of advertisements were published for the appointment of full-time lecturers, but either the recommended candidates did not join, or there were not enough applications. However, both the college authorities as well as the Directorate of Higher Education are aware of the situation and are engaged actively in finding a suitable person for the remaining stipulated post.

The Govt, of Mizoram has been already approached for financial assistance.

13. Librarian : Yes, the Librarian is a Master Degree holder in Library Science from NEHU(1993: 54%). She is working on a part time basis with consolidated remuneration of Rs. 2000/- p.m.

14. When was the Last Governing Body Meeting? : Governing Body meeting was held on 8.7.98. there are 11 members in the present Governing Body(List enclosed)

15. Any other relevant information/Points : The Aizawl Law College was started in 1993 with the support of the people of Mizoram. It is a pioneering institution in the entire North Eastern Region in imparting legal education to the students. The College has so far produced 73 Law Graduates.

Steps have been already initiated to have a good, spacious College building of its own within a short time.

16. Conditions/Requirements:-

The Inspection Team visited the Aizawl Law College on 17th July 1998 at 4 p.m. and inspected and found that the College needs the following essential conditions/requirements to be fulfilled.

1. The Principal is an M.A. in Pol. Sc, Ph. D(Pol.Sc) and LL.B from Guwahati University. Besides, he was serving in Judicial Department of Mizoram for 22 years and retired as Law Secretary. But as per the Bar Council provision the Principal of law College has to be a Master of Law and must be appointed on a full time basis. Since he has a long experiences of serving in the Judicial Department of the Government of Mizoram, the Team feels recommends that he may be considered to be permitted to continue as the Principal of the College till a suitable Person with required qualification is appointed:

- (2) The Team recommends ~~that~~ two more qualified teachers as per the Bar Council provisions need to be appointed on priority basis. The Team is seeking relaxation on this count for two teachers (Sl No.4 and 6) who are having 7 and 6 years experience at BAR instead of the required 10 years as stipulated by the BAR Council for non LL.M degree-holders.
- (3). The Team recommends that the College authorities must take initiative to construct the building of the college at the earliest possible.
- (4) Qualified Full time Librarian must be immediately appointed to look after the Library Section of the Law College.
- (5) As per the available records, it appears that the Provisional Affiliation for three years w.e.f. 24th Dec,1993 was granted to the College which expired on December, 1996. There is a lapse of 1 year and 7 months as on the Inspection Date of the present team ~~which~~ may be regularised by the University as the team feels. However, in this regard, the law college authorities have already paid Rs.5000/- for getting its reaffiliation on 12.11.97 Vide Bank Draft MTTB/40 " 389976" dated 20.10.97, as received and acknowledged by the C.D.C. NEHU, Vide notification No. CDC/C81/1026/dated 12.11.1997.
17. Recommendations: The Inspection Team strongly recommends the renewal of the Provisional Affiliation of the Aizawl Law College for 3 years subject to the fulfillment of the above mentioned conditions/requirements in larger interests of the College and law education in Mizoram.
