

(1) INCLUSION OF NEHUNSA AS MEMBER OF E.C.

The NEHU, by virtue of being an Autonomous body, has the Executive Council which is the Supreme authority and the highest decision-making body in all matters including Academic and Administrative. But till date none of the members from the non-teaching staff have been included as members of the said body to represent administration, whereas with regards to Academic side, there is ample representation. As a result there is a feeling amongst the non-teaching staff that only the interest of the Academic sector is well safe-guarded and perhaps no proper attention could be paid to the interests of the non-teaching staff in absence of any representative on the apex body.

In this connection, a representation from the non-teaching staff have been received through their Association to allow 2 (two) representatives from their side to be the members in the said body, (as Annexure 'A').

The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.
