Syiem, Officer on Special Duty, NEHU, Shillong may be paid the monthly rent of Rs.2883.35p from the date of his joining on 10.3.89 as he is entitled to residential accommodation of the University as per the provision of the Ordinance*

2. The non-technical staff may be transferred within NEHU but transferability will not apply to technical staff

3. The rules of the University will apply in respect of promotions of technical staff.
