

- ii) Application for posts in respect of faculty members within the University during the probationary period.

A request have been received from faculty members of the University that they be allowed to apply the post advertised by the University during the probationary period.

In this context, the Executive Council in its 12th meeting vide No. EC: 12: 76: 79 had decided that application for posts outside the University should be routed through proper channel. Secondly, no member of the staff shall be permitted to apply for a post during the period of probation or within the first two years of of his appointment whichever is later. The Executive is completely silent for whether the above decision is also binding on University teachers who would like to apply for another post advertised in other Departments of the University.

However, the restriction imposed at Para (ii) of the said EC decision on its applicability of the probationary period in principle have to be completed before being eligible for applying any posts whether departmental or external.

The matter was placed before 59th meeting of the Academic and the Council considered the bar to apply for posts within the University during the period of probation and RESOVED that the bar be not made applicable in such cases.
